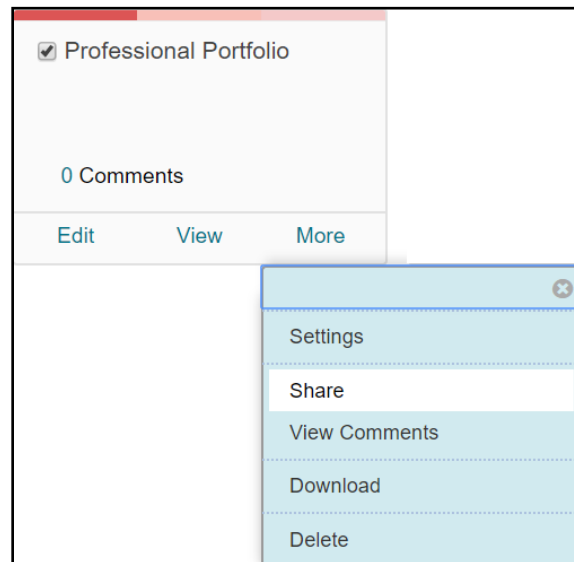


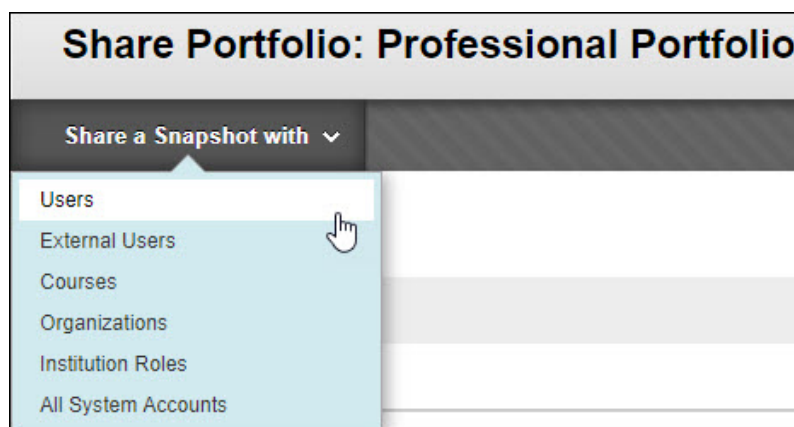
Share a Portfolio with TTU Blackboard Users

You can share your portfolio with people who are faculty, staff, or other students at your institution.

1. On the **My Portfolios** page, click the **More** link for the portfolio you want to share, then click **Share**.



2. On the **Share Portfolio** page, click the **Share a Snapshot with** drop-down menu and select **Users**.



3. On the **Share with User** page, enter the eRaider username(s) in the **Username** textbox or click the **Browse** button to search for the user(s).

Share with User: Professional Portfolio

This Portfolio will be searchable by the selected users from Discover Portfolios.

*To share this Portfolio, enter one or more Usernames or click **Browse** to search. Separate multiple Usernames with commas.*

NOTE To search for the user(s) after clicking the **Browse** button, use the drop-down menus and enter the search criteria in the textbox, then click **Go**. From the list of search results, select the user(s) that you want to share your portfolio with and click **Submit**. The user(s) that you selected appears in the **Username** textbox.
