## Texas Tech University Uniform Graduation Requirements

### 1. Foreign Language Requirement

*Students graduating from Texas Tech University should be able to express, negotiate, and interpret meaning in a second language.*

Any entering student who has not completed two years of a single foreign language in high school must complete at least two semesters (or its equivalent) of a single foreign language at the first-year college level **or** at least one semester of a foreign language at a 2000 level or higher as a graduation requirement. This requirement may also be satisfied by transferring in the equivalent courses from another college or university. Individual Texas Tech University colleges may have additional foreign language proficiency requirements. Additional requirements may be necessary for select majors.

### 2. Science Laboratory Requirement

Students graduating from Texas Tech University are required to complete two semester credit hours of science laboratory courses. Normally this will be done by taking two 4-credit science courses or combinations of lecture and lab.

### 3. Communication Literacy Requirement

Students will complete the required communication literacy requirement.

### 4. Core Curriculum Requirement

Students will complete the required core curriculum.

### 5. Multicultural Requirement

In addition to the State of Texas core curriculum, every student must include at least one 3-hour multicultural course or its equivalent that focuses explicitly on the distinctive subcultures of the United States or on the culture of another society.

**Maximum number of transferrable semester credits hours from a two-year institution applicable to a baccalaureate degree at the university is 80.**

## Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

### Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to TTU degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at TTU
- All courses must receive a grade of C or higher.
- LSC Honors students admitted to TU will receive:
  - Acceptance to TTU Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - TTU will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
- Transfer Scholarships available:

  - \$6,500 - 3.5 GPA with 60 transferable hours
  - \$4,500 – 3.0 GPA with 30 transferable hours

### Program Admission Requirements

- Admission to the College of Education does not guarantee admission to TechTeach.
- All Freshman (1XXX) and Sophomore (2XXX) level courses must be completed prior to applying to TechTeach.
- All courses must receive a grade of C or higher; GPA of 2.75 is required for admission and graduation.
- Students should request a criminal background check to ensure eligibility. See [educ.ttu.edu](http://educ.ttu.edu) for more details.

### Program Specific Requirements

- Before accepting admission to the program, you should be aware that you may request a criminal background check to ensure eligibility. See [educ.ttu.edu](http://educ.ttu.edu) for more details.
- The State of Texas conducts a criminal background check on all applicants for Teacher Certification. This could prevent program completion pending a negative check.
- The undergraduate requirements and/or the certification requirements may change according to state regulations.
- The official admission date will be the first day of classes for each Fall semester at Texas Tech University.
- Pass PPR #160 to complete certification.
- Complete certification within 2 calendar years.
- Complete final 30 hours at Texas Tech.
