

How to: Connect to TTUnet VPN on Windows

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Introduction

NOTE:

- The TTUnet VPN service must be enabled on your eRaider account before you can establish a connection. You may request access or verify that VPN is enabled for your account by submitting a VPN assistance request.
- VPN is not necessary for Remote Desktop Connections to Windows PCs from off campus. When using Remote Desktop, simply configure the connection to use TTU's RDP Gateway.
- The TTUnet VPN service provides a secure tunnel to to the TTU network only. It is not intended to be a commercial VPN service for the purposes of encrypting all of your Internet communications. Network communications from your computer/device to non-TTU services will not be sent through the VPN connection.

Instructions

- 1) If you have not already done so, download and install the GlobalProtect VPN software.
- 2) In the bottom right-hand corner of your screen (Notification Area), click the "GlobalProtect" icon.



TIP: If you do not see the icon, you may need to click the disclosure arrow to reveal it.



3) For the portal address, type **vpn.ttu.edu**. Then, click **Connect**.



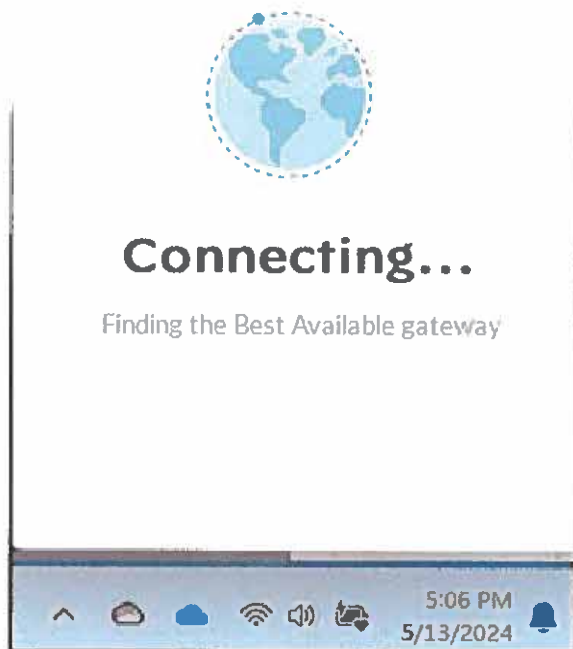

When you see the dialog on the browser, click **Open GlobalProtect**. If the dialog does not appear, [click here](#) to launch GlobalProtect.

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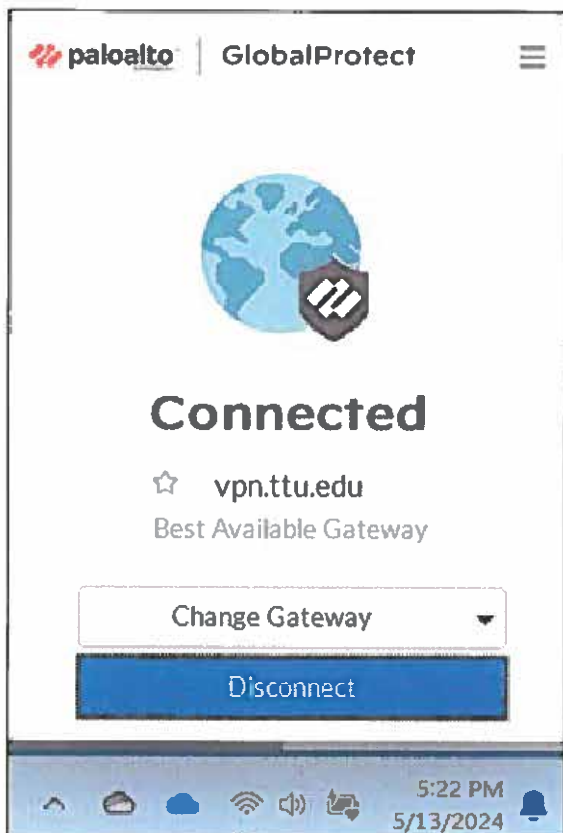
6) Please wait while the connection is established.
