Scholarship	Requirements
Heather Anderson Endowment in Geosciences	UG student(s) majoring in Geoscience or Geophysics who maintains a GPA average of 3.0. based on financial need, by scholarship selection committee with approval of the chair.
Ann and Dennis Bell Geology Endowed Scholarship	Student in GEOS awarded for field course semester. Student must show evidence of at least an average of 15 hours per week part-time employment in the semester prior to the field course. Student should have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 and a Geosciences GPA of 2.8.
Jason and Nancy Currie Scholarship Endowment in Geosciences	Undergraduate Geosciences majors. Students must maintain a 2.75 GPA. Students will also be selected based on financial need. Students will be selected by the scholarship committee with approval from the dean.
Frank M Hall Endowed Scholarship	Students majoring in Geophysics or Geology preferably Geophysics and maintaining a 3.0 GPA. The scholarship recipients are to be selected annually by the Scholarship Committee with the approval of the Department Chair.
Alonzo D Jacka Endowed Scholarship	Undergraduate (jr, sr) or graduate students geosciences - geology. To support research in sedimentary petrology, especially as applied to hydrocarbon exploration and production. Based on research achievement and academic merit under criteria established by the department. Renewable.

Lubbock Gem and Mineral Society	Undergraduate student (sophomore, jr., or sr.) pursuing a degree in the field of Earth Sciences with 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Financial need to be considered.
