GRADUATE SCHOOL NOTIFICATION

TTU requires the Graduate School to track all external fellowship and scholarship applications.

From the “Funding Your Education” tab under “External Fellowships & Grants” there is a “Submit & Follow-up” menu

- You will be asked to log in using your eRaider ID and password
- Complete the requested information at least 1 week prior to the fellowship/scholarship deadline
- You will receive a notification from the Graduate School that it is okay for **you** to submit the application



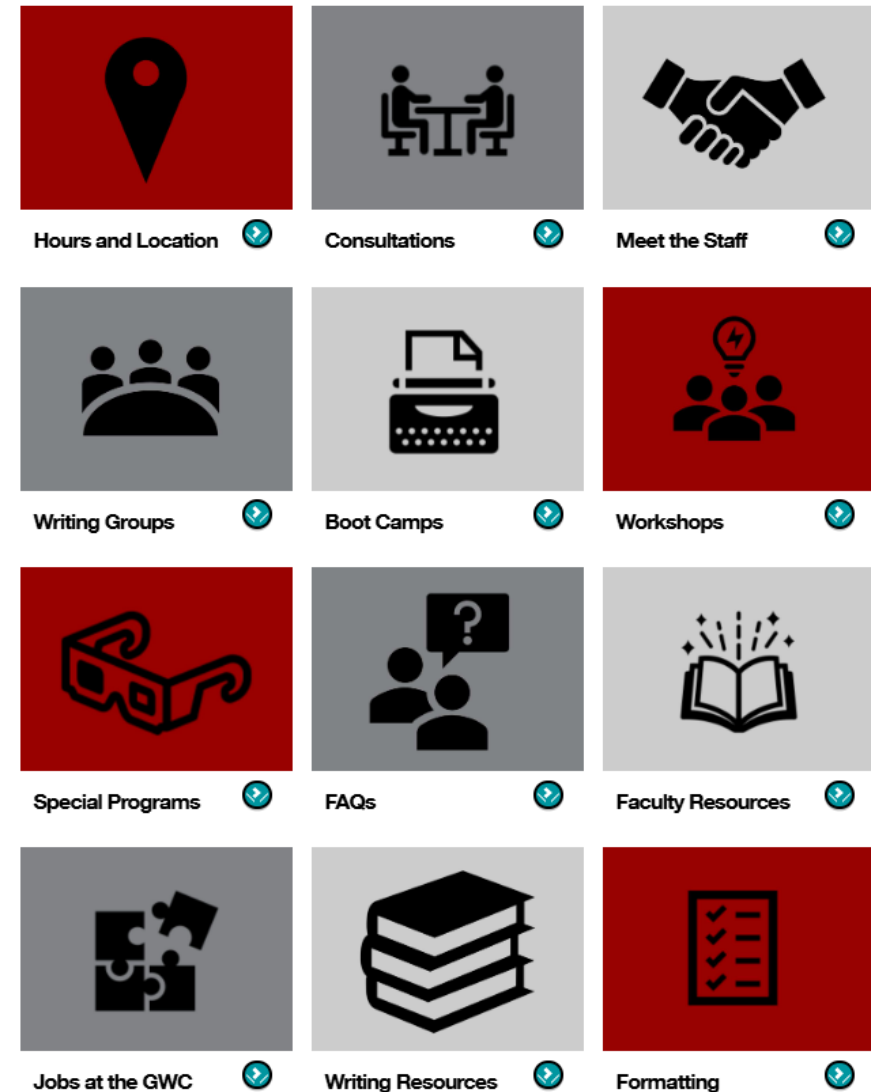

FINAL NOTES

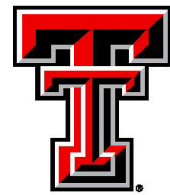
- Start early! Some academic majors are more difficult to find external funding opportunities, so make sure to give yourself enough time to submit prior to our deadlines.
- Yearly requirement submission dates are June 1, 2025 – May 31, 2026.
- Funding is subject to **cancellation** if yearly requirements are not met.
