



HONORS HOURS TRACKING SHEET

A minimum total of 24 hours of Honors coursework is required;

Final grades of B- or higher must be earned for application to Honors/HE+ credit.

General Honors Coursework (18 Hours) <i>These courses can include the First-Year Experience (FYE) and Learning Community Group (LCG) courses required of incoming first-year Honors students, Honors Enhanced (HE+) courses, conventional Honors sections at any level, approved Honors contracts for upper-level or graduate courses, approved Study Abroad contracts, and/or approved Independent Study opportunities. *Limits may apply to contracts.</i>	Semester	Hours
3000-Level Honors Seminar (3 Hours) <i>This requirement can only be completed with a conventional Honors section designated in the course booklet as a 3000-level Honors seminar. Contracts, HE+ sections, or other substitutions cannot apply.</i>	Semester	Hours
4000-Level Honors Seminar (3 Hours) <i>This requirement can only be completed with a conventional Honors section designated in the course booklet as a 4000-level Honors seminar. Contracts, HE+ sections, or other substitutions cannot apply.</i>	Semester	Hours

Completion of these 24 hours of Honors requirements—and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5—should allow an Honors student to graduate ***With Honors from the Honors College.***

Honors students have the option to complete 6 **additional** hours of Honors credit beyond the minimum 24 (specifically HONS 3300 and HONS 4300) in order to write an Honors Thesis to graduate ***With Highest Honors from the Honors College.***
