REQUIREMENTS FOR THE “3+3” EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM (A&S majors only)
Students will complete the last year of undergraduate work at the School of Law and these SOL classes (29hrs) will complete requirements for the required A&S minor and electives.

- ___ Undergraduate GPA of at least a 3.5
- ___ LSAT score that places the student in the top half nationwide by December of application year
- ___ SAT of at least 1300 or an ACT of at least 29
- ___ Active member in good standing with the Honors College (including a 3 long semester residency requirement)
- ___ Making satisfactory progress toward an Arts and Sciences B.A. or B.S. degree with a designation in Honors Studies
- ___ At least 100 semester hours of undergraduate work (all requirements for degree met OTHER than those for minor and electives)
- ___ Last 30 hours of this 100 must be completed at Texas Tech
- ___ Degree plan filed with an A&S major and a Law minor at least one semester prior to beginning coursework at the SOL

Students must submit an official SOL transcript to the College of Arts and Sciences (102 Holden Hall) following the first year of Law School in order to be eligible for a baccalaureate degree. Total transfer hours (from the SOL or another college) cannot exceed 30 hours. See the A&S website for more info: www.prelaw.ttu.edu

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EARLY DECISION PROGRAM (all majors eligible)
Enrollment in the School of Law would not occur until *after* the student receives a baccalaureate degree.

- ___ Undergraduate GPA of at least a 3.5
- ___ LSAT score that places the student in the top half nationwide by December of application year
- ___ SAT of at least 1300 or an ACT of at least 29
- ___ Active member in good standing with the Honors College (including a 3 long semester residency requirement)
- ___ Making satisfactory progress toward a baccalaureate degree with a designation in Honors Studies

Honors courses *in progress or needed* to complete 24hr requirement (list course numbers and semester of *planned* completion). Two law classes may substitute for junior/senior level Honors requirements (6hr substitution limit) in 3+3 program only.
