This ongoing project seeks to provide innovative care, support, and resources to those patients and their families that are experiencing post-traumatic stress (PTS) following a severe physical injury. These innovations to reduce PTS symptoms are being informed by present literature and research and ultimately will be evaluated through our own research to evaluate its efficacy on this population.
