CCRC APPLICATION

The Center for Collegiate Recovery Communities ("The Center") at Texas Tech University provides a nurturing, affirming environment in which students recovering from addictive disorders can successfully pursue academic, personal, and professional goals for the purpose of enhancing their quality of life. The Center is open to all students in recovery who are actively pursuing higher education at Texas Tech University and who are committed to growth in recovery.

The Center offers scholarships to current members who exhibit continuing commitment to leadership and academics. Students wishing to receive a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must have at least one continuous year of complete abstinence from alcohol and other drugs and/or one year of actively seeking recovery in non-abstinence based behavioral addictions (i.e. eating disorders/sex addiction/etc.) during the first semester in the CCRC.
- 2. Must enroll for, and complete, at least 12 hours (undergraduate) or 9 hours (graduate) credit per semester, with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or greater.
- 3. Must be committed to recovery growth and leadership within the recovery community.

All students receiving scholarships are required to:

- Continue in their recovery without relapse
- Complete a full course load (12 hours for undergraduate, 9 hours for graduate) each semester
- Meet specified GPA of 3.0 or above each semester
- Actively and fully participate in student seminar with letter grade of A
- Show leadership in the Collegiate Recovery Community measured by attitude, character and integrity, respect for diversity, and service.
- Submit a donor thank you letter
- Submit a dossier every spring if you are continuing your education with the TTU CCRC the following semester

Note: This is not a multiyear award; there are no guarantees of your scholarship from year to year.

Students are required to resubmit scholarship applications each year to be eligible for renewal of their scholarship.
