The Center for Collegiate Recovery Communities (CCRC) at Texas Tech University (TTU) is an abstinence-based program that affirms students in recovery from alcohol or substance use, eating disorders / disordered eating, or other behavioral addictions. The CCRC recognizes students in all types of recovery can successfully pursue academic, personal, and professional goals to enhance quality of life while also benefitting the university and the Lubbock community. The Collegiate Recovery Community (CRC) is open to all students who are in recovery, who are actively pursuing higher education at Texas Tech University, and who are committed to personal growth and development.

The CCRC offers scholarships to current members who exhibit a commitment to strengthening recovery, achieving academic goals, engaging in civility, and building the CRC community.

At this time, scholarships are only available for fall / spring semesters and spring / summer semesters. If the CCRC awards a scholarship to an out-of-state student, the student is eligible to pay the TTU in-state tuition.

Students wishing to receive a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Have at least one continuous year of recovery acquired during the first semester in the CCRC.
2. Enroll in and complete at least 12 hours (undergraduate) or 9 hours (graduate) per semester, maintaining a GPA. of 3.0 or greater.

**NOTE:**

For new incoming students, prior GPA is waived when a CCRC scholarship is awarded.

3. Enroll in Community Seminar and maintain an "A" grade during each semester.

4. Submit the Scholarship Acceptance Form by April 15th

5. Write a donor thank you letter, using the suggested format, and submit the thank you letter through the online system by April 15.

**NOTE:**

Fall application is due February 15. (fall / spring award)

Spring application is due October 31. (spring / summer award)
