CHARGE

The Student Services Committee will serve in an advisory capacity and assist with college efforts and activities related to undergraduate and graduate recruitment, retention and commencement.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Recruitment:
 - a. Collaborate with Student Services staff on new ideas for promoting CHHS undergraduate and graduate programs.
 - b. Attend recruitment events as needed.
- 2. Retention:
 - a. Serve in an advisory capacity to Student Services staff regarding centralized retention efforts.
 - b. Work within the member's department to identify ways to enhance retention efforts and share best practices with the committee.
 - c. Assist in reviewing the CHHS Dean's Merit Scholarship awardees.
- 3. Commencement:
 - a. Assist in the CHHS banner bearer selection process.
 - b. Assist with commencement related events upon request.
- Coordinate with the Student Services Office staff to provide incoming and current students requested information regarding program of study.
- 5. Encourage faculty and staff to actively participate in recruitment and retention efforts.

MEMBERSHIP

- Co-conveners: Academic Advising and Retention Office Director and Recruitment Office Director
- 2. Members: Two representatives from each department will be appointed by Department Chairs in consultation with the Assistant Dean for Undergraduate Student Services. Suggested committee members are program directors from departments.



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- 3. Ex-officio member: CHHS Marketing and Communication representative
- 4. Other student services staff will participate as needed.
- 5. The term of the appointment is one year. Reappointment is permissible.
