Minimum Qualifications:

A Master's Degree in Retailing, or Marketing, a Ph.D. in either field is preferred. Must be either in or willing to relocate to Costa Rica. Preference given to those with demonstrated teaching experience at the university level, particularly courses related to retail management, entrepreneurship, and/or marketing courses. Highly desirable to have had an executive/professional career in retailing and/or marketing. Experience teaching remotely in a synchronous environment is desirable. Experience researching in areas such as branding, place branding, tourism, destination tourism (food, wine, sustainability, experiential, etc.) is highly desirable.

Responsibilities:

Teach retailing management courses at the undergraduate levels at Texas Tech University – Costa Rica. The instructor will participate in program development and serve on departmental and university committees. Actively outreach to the community and develop a strong record of community engagement. Develop a robust stream of research related to sustainable and experiential tourism with particular interest in branding and retail aspects that can be supported through the acquisition of external funding. Preference will be given to those who have a demonstrated research record in these areas or closely related topics.
