Two Elective Areas of Concentration (18-21) hours

Students will choose courses in two elective areas of concentration. At least one of these concentrations must come from the College of Health and Human Sciences. Options include: Community, Family, and Addiction Sciences; Design, Family and Consumer Sciences Education; Interdisciplinary Health & Human Sciences; Hospitality and Retail Management; Human Development and Family Sciences; Nutritional Sciences; and Personal Financial Planning.

Students can choose to apply coursework from select TTU graduate certificates to fulfill degree requirements. Some possible choices include: Charitable Financial Planning; Early Childhood & Family Policy; Financial Health and Wellness; Gerontology; Human-Centered Design; Human Sciences Education and Training; Youth Development Specialist; Youth Program Management and Evaluation; and Women's and Gender Studies. Advisor approval is required.
