

2023 - 2024 COHS General Seed Grant Funding - Fall

The COHS Research Office will fund seed grants to COHS faculty for a research project of any topic. The grant is designed to provide funding for a project that will produce pilot data to be used in an external grant submission.

Award:

The COHS will fund up to 5 grants of \$5,000 each. The grant should be used for research materials and supplies necessary to conduct your research (including the cost of human subject participation, animal cost, hourly undergraduate and graduate student support). Faculty salary and travel will not be covered by this award. This grant also is not to provide research money to be used for many projects or activities, but for one specific project outlined in the application.

Application (3 page limit):

The application includes

- 1. Description of the research, including methodology and potential impact
- 2. Detailed timeline for project completion
- 3. Detailed budget and budget justification
- 4. Identification of external grant to be applied for based on the proposed project
- 5. Any additional funding you currently have for this particular project from any source, if applicable

Review Criteria:

Proposals will be evaluated based on

- 1. Submitting a complete application
- 2. Clarity of research project
- 3. Scientific merit/potential impact
- 4. Feasibility/timeline of the project
- 5. Appropriate budget and budget justification

Review:

Proposals will be reviewed by members of the COHS Research Committee, who will make a recommendation to the Associate Dean for Research regarding which proposals are to be funded. Note that members of the Research Committee are eligible to apply but must recuse themselves during evaluation of their application.

Applications are due October 6, 2023 by 5pm (CT)

All award funding should be encumbered or spent by August 31, 2024. Funding report form is due September 30, 2024.
