

2023 - 2024 COHS Come N Go Domestic Research Collaboration Seed Grant

The College of Human Sciences (COHS) Research Office is pleased to announce the 2023 - 2024 Come N Go Domestic Research Collaboration Seed Grant. This funding opportunity is for COHS faculty and a collaborator(s) from another U.S. Institution to visit each other's campuses and to design a collaborative research project that will eventuate in the collection of preliminary data and the *mandatory* submission of a federal grant.

Award:

Up to 2 awards of \$6,000 each will be made depending upon the quality and number of proposals. Funds are to be used for domestic travel (and research related expenses) of the TTU faculty member and their collaborator to visit each other's campuses to interactively design and subsequently collect preliminary data for the expressed purpose of submitting a federal grant (no private or state funding agencies considered). During their time on the TTU campus, in addition to meeting with their TTU counterpart regarding the grant, it is expected that the visiting collaborator(s) will present a research colloquium to the College, Department, or Course or make themselves generally available to interact with interested faculty and students.

Application:

A COHS faculty PI and his/her collaborators will work together to prepare a single application. The application includes

1. A brief CV (2 pages maximum) for each member of the research team

Limit of 3 pages total for the following:

- 2. Description of the proposed project, significance of the proposed project and roles of you and your collaborator in the project
- 3. Detailed timeline for project completion
- 4. Detailed budget and budget justification
- Specific federal grant you will apply for based on data generated from this project

Review Criteria:

Proposals will be evaluated based on

- 1. Submitting a complete application
- 2. Clarity of proposal
- 3. Scientific merit/potential impact of proposed project
- 4. Feasibility/timeline of the project
- 5. Appropriate budget and budget justification

Proposal Review:

Proposals will be reviewed by members of the COHS Research Committee, who will make a



recommendation to the Associate Dean for Research regarding which proposals are to be funded. Note that COHS Research Committee members are eligible to apply but must recuse themselves during evaluation of their proposal.

Application Due: September 22, 2023 by 5pm (CT)
All award funding should be encumbered or spent by August 31, 2024.
Funding report form is due September 30, 2024.
