2024-2025 CHHS Health and Wellness Research Seed Grant

The College of Health and Human Sciences (CHHS) announces a grant for CHHS faculty to develop projects related to any aspect of health and wellness (e.g., psychological well-being, relationships, environments, nutrition, tourism, etc.). Recipients of this grant will be expected to submit an external grant proposal using preliminary data generated by this seed funding as the foundation of their submission.

Who is eligible?

- Full-time CHHS faculty (professors of practice and tenure-track faculty)
- Priority will be given to proposals with faculty from 2 or more units in CHHS

What is the grant amount and what can it be used for?

Two grants up to \$10,000 each will be awarded and can be used for materials and supplies necessary to conduct the research (including the cost of human subject participation, hourly graduate or undergraduate assistant support, etc.). Faculty salary and travel will not be covered by the award.

What is required in the proposal?

The proposal is limited to 3 pages and includes:

1. Description of the research, including methodology and potential impact
2. Detailed timeline for project completion
3. Detailed budget and budget justification
4. External grant to be applied for based on pilot data

How will proposals be reviewed?

Proposals will be evaluated based on

1. Submitting a complete application
2. Clarity of research project
3. Scientific merit/potential impact
4. Feasibility/timeline of the project
5. Appropriate budget and budget justification
6. Interdisciplinary -- Priority will be given to proposals that include faculty from two (or more) of the units in CHHS.

Who will review proposals?

Members of the CHHS Research Committee will review proposals and make recommendations to the Associate Dean for Research. Members of the Research Committee are eligible to apply and will not review their own proposals.

When is the proposal due?

October 25, 2024 by 5pm

When does the grant money need to be spent/encumbered?

December 31, 2025

When is a report of grant activity due?

January 31, 2026
