2024- 2025 CHHS Mid-Career Faculty Grant

The College of Health and Human Sciences Dean's Office invites CHHS tenure-track Associate Professors to apply for funds to provide professional development assistance to work toward career progression to Professor.

Who is eligible?

- Tenure-track CHHS associate professors without endowed professorships/endowed chair positions and who have not previously received this award

What is the grant amount and what can it be used for?

One award of \$10,000 in each of the 7 units in the CHHS may be made, depending on the quality and number of proposals. Funds may be used for course buyouts, summer pay, travel, and other research expenses (e.g., human subject payments, animal costs, etc.). Work related to this award will occur between Summer 2025 and Summer 2026.

What is required in the proposal?

The proposal is limited to 3 pages and includes

1. Detailed description of proposed work/focus of your research
2. Explanation of how this work will promote career progression
3. Detailed timeline for completion of proposed project(s)
4. Detailed budget and budget justification
5. Email statement of support from your Department Chair/School Director to Malinda Colwell and explanation of any financial commitments the unit will make to support your work on the proposed project(s), if applicable.

How will the proposal be reviewed?

Proposals will be evaluated based on

1. Submitting a complete application
2. Clarity of proposed work
3. Evidence of how proposed work will promote career progression to full professor
4. Feasibility/timeline of the project
5. Appropriate budget and budget justification

Who will review the proposal?

The Associate Dean for Academics and Faculty and the Associate Dean for Research will review proposals.

When is the proposal due?

February 21, 2025 by 5pm

When does the grant money need to be spent/encumbered?

August 31, 2026

When is the report of grant activity due?

September 30, 2026
