Rabies	Rabies virus	Bites/scratches of diseased animals	Vaccination for persons working in high risk areas; use respiratory protection in bat caves; use gloves when handling animals; avoid bite wounds; report bites to physician

Physical Hazards:

- Includes animal induced injuries:

- Also may include the inhalation of dust or fecal material in enclosed caves.
