To access the CITI Training, which is free through Texas Tech University, use the following:

Create an account and look around. Most of the courses listed are for animal users.

On the right hand side in the "Create an account" section, Click on: "Register"

Select "Texas Tech University" under "Participating Institutions"

Click on: "Continue to Step 2"

Enter "First Name" and "Last Name" and "Email Address"

Click on: "Continue to Step 3"

Enter a "User Name" and "Password" and choose a "Security question" in case you forget your password/login

Click on: "Continue to Step 4"

Demographic information is optional...otherwise select "I choose not to disclose"

Click on: "Continue to Step 5"

Select "No" for CEU Credits...unless you personally need them. CEU Credits are generally utilized by professionals (i.e., doctors, nurses) that need to demonstrate ongoing career training.

Click on: "Continue to Step 6"

Enter Identifier information...minimal required fields. This allows you to be found in the training system to confirm that you have completed and passed the training.

Click on: "Continue to Step 7"

Choose your course. Make sure you choose which "Animal Care and Use" courses you would like to complete.

Click "Complete Registration"

Continue to your course.

NOTE: Another benefit, for trainees that have completed CITI training at another institution, you can add TTU to your list of affiliations and our administrators will be able to see what training you have already completed.
