Research Highlights

Texas Tech University was awarded **\$450,000** to host three doctoral students from Ghana as part of **USAID's Borlaug Higher Education for Agricultural Research and Development (BHEARD)** program. **Conrad Lyford**, associate professor of **Agricultural & Applied Economics**, and **Venugopal Mendu**, assistant professor of **Plant & Soil Science**, are recipients of the award. Texas Tech was the only non-land grant university selected under the BHEARD program. This program is funded through USAID and administered by Michigan State University. Qualifications for the award include national competitiveness of the Ph.D. degree program and experience and expertise of the faculty advisor.
