

# Why Should You Study Abroad?

We live in a global society. Study abroad is one way you can prepare yourself to thrive in an increasingly international environment. Whether you have an international experience requirement or you are simply drawn to the adventure of stepping outside your comfort zone, the benefits of study abroad are clear.

# Reasons to Study Abroad

- Explore the world while earning academic credit.
- Enhance your resume with real-world experiences like international internships and research.
- Deepen your commitment to education and learning.
- Improve skills such as problem solving, adaptability, resiliency, and intercultural communication.
- Grow in self-awareness.





Take classes with TTU faculty, study at the TTU Sevilla Center or the campus in San Jose, Costa Rica, or attend a partner university in one of 50 countries around the world.

#### **Study Abroad Eligibility**

TTU Red Raiders who maintain a 2.0 GPA (2.75 for Business majors) and are in good disciplinary standing with the University are eligible to study abroad after they have completed two semesters on campus. Transfer students must complete one semester at Texas Tech before studying abroad.

# The TTU Sevilla Center

The TTU Center in Sevilla, Spain has a 20+ year history of hosting Red Raiders. The Center offers summer and semester programs with courses available in Spanish, Engineering, Architecture, Pre-Health and more. Internships including medical shadowing are available. Excursions are included to nearby cities, plus students can travel on their own in their free time. Homestay families complement the immersive, cultural experience in Sevilla and provide a full meal plan. Students study with other Red Raiders and receive on-site support from local faculty and staff.

Includes supervised medical shadowing in local clinics and hospitals


Practice your Spanish medical terminology necessary for your future healthcare career




