

Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by 100-Mile Increments











New Enrolled Freshmen by Ethnicity




New Freshmen Distribution by State




One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen* Fall 2003 to Fall 2007





SAT Composite Scores of All New Freshmen*




ACT Composite Scores of All New Freshmen*






