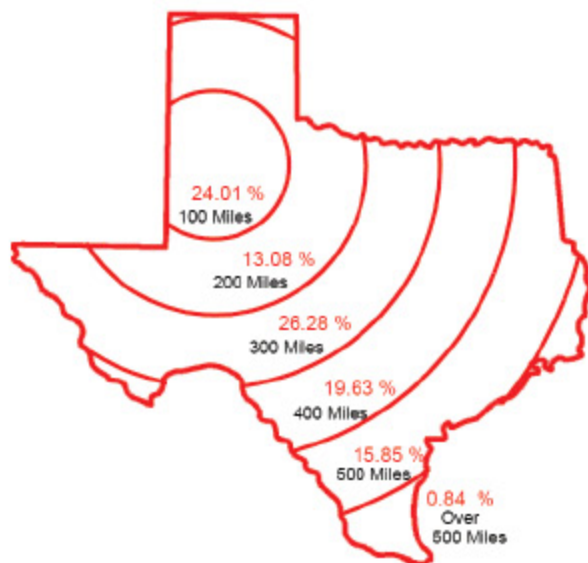
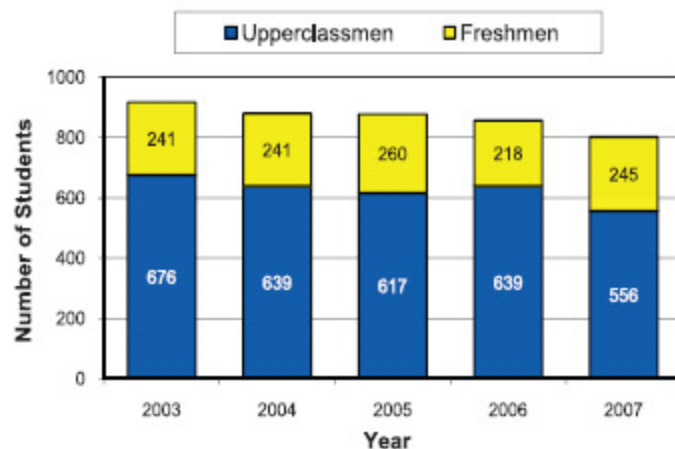


Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by 100-Mile Increments

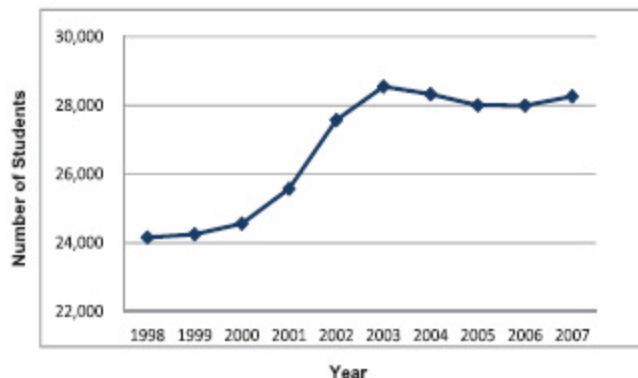

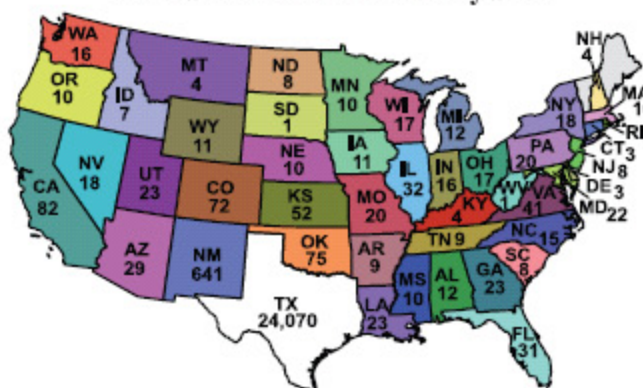

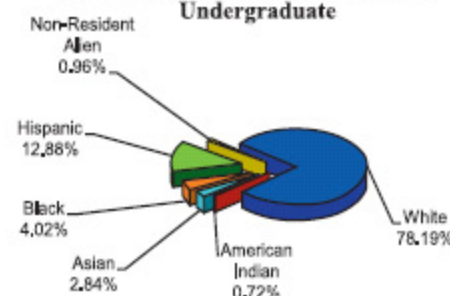
Total Enrollment by Gender Undergraduate



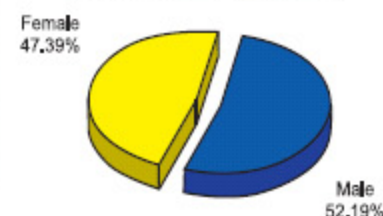

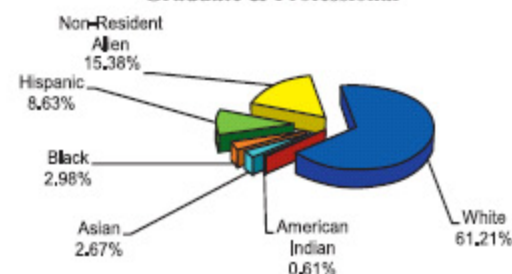
Total Enrollment by Ethnicity Undergraduate

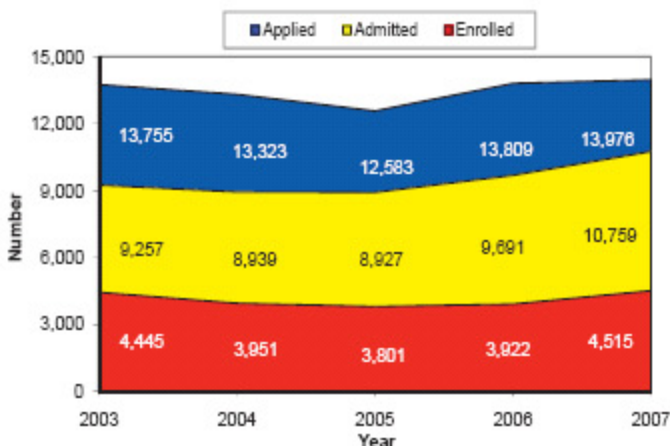

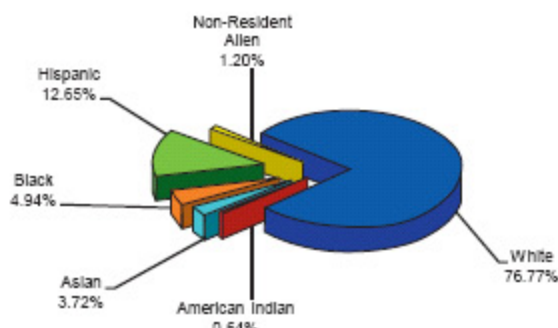

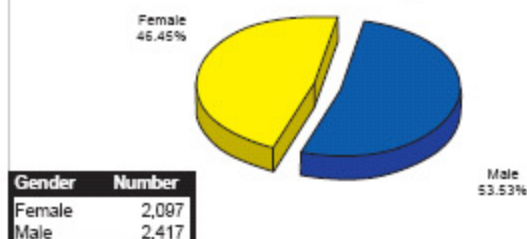

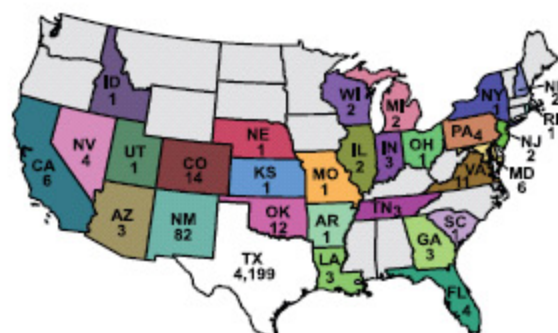
New Enrolled Freshmen by Ethnicity



New Enrolled Freshmen by Gender



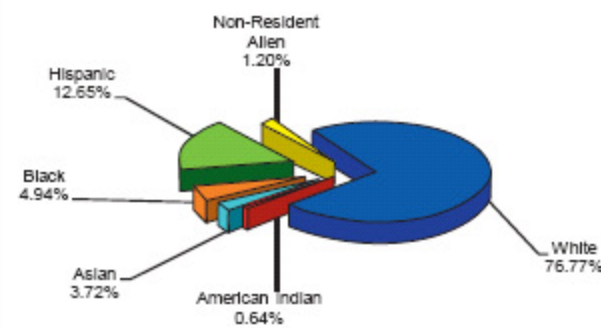
New Freshmen Distribution by State



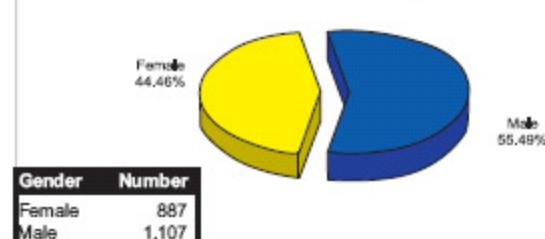

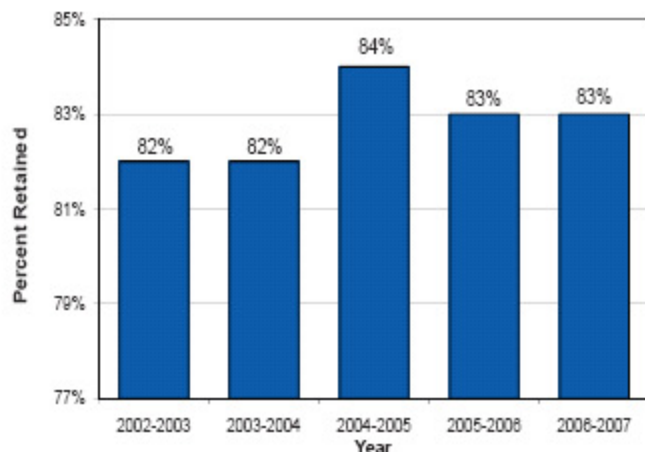

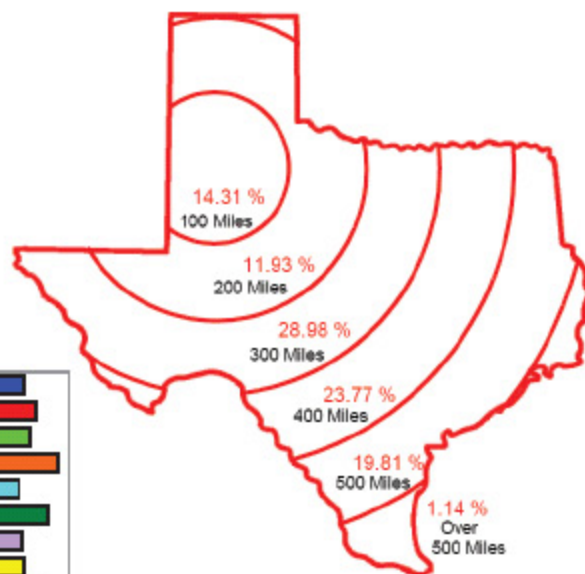
One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen* Fall 2003 to Fall 2007

Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by 100-Mile Increments

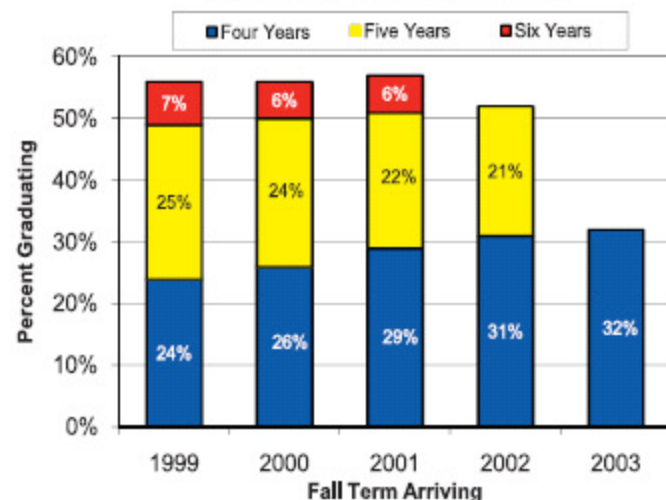

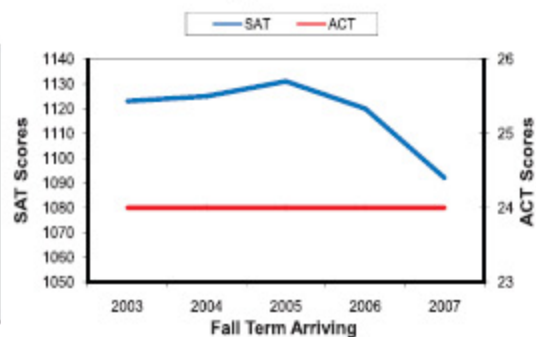

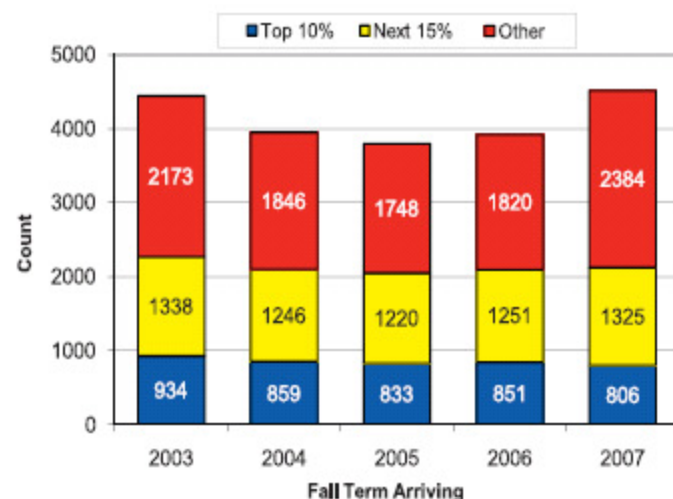
