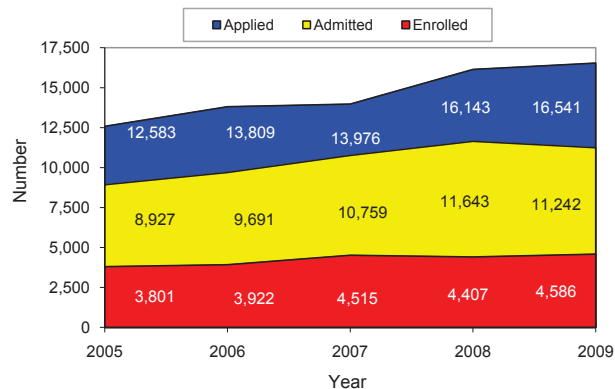

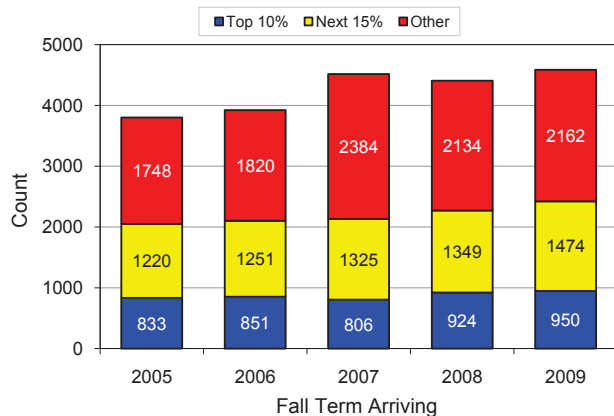

New Freshmen from High School by High School Rank

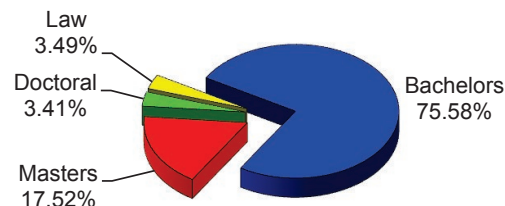

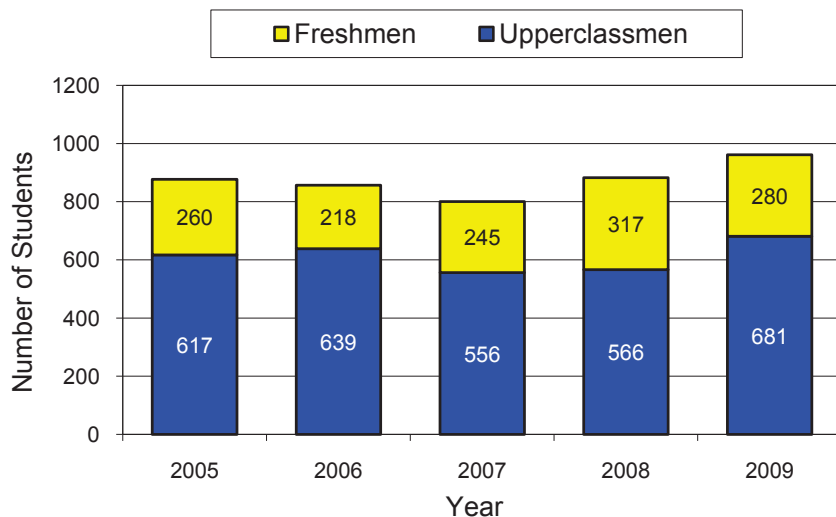

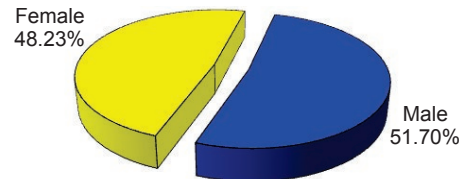

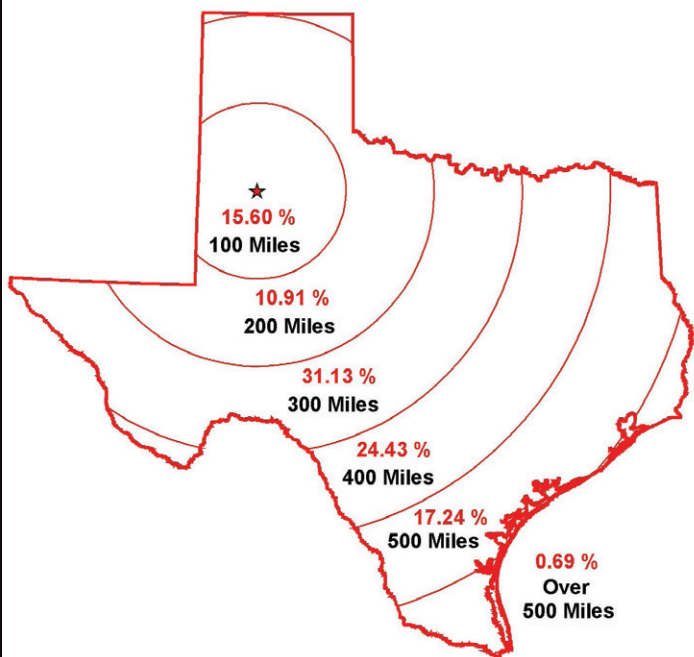

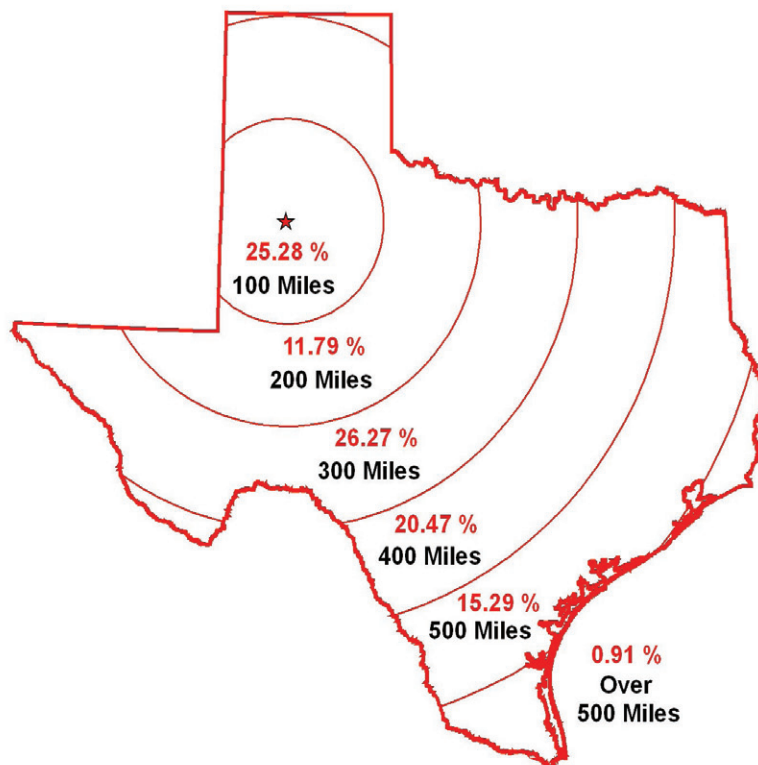

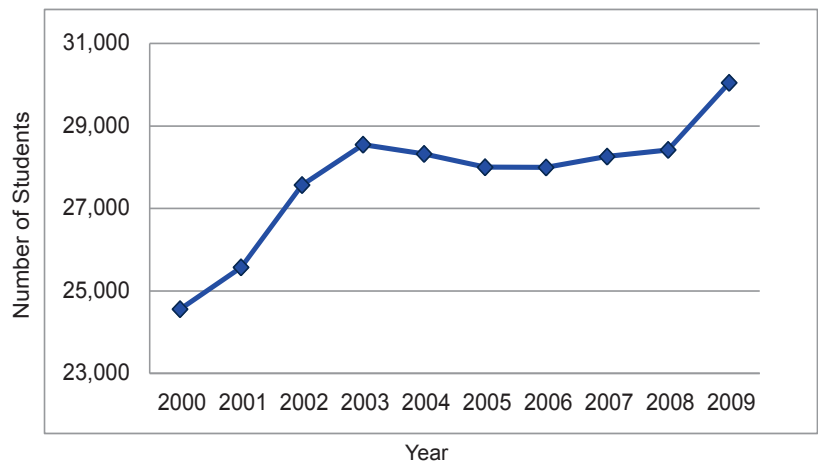


**Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas
by 100-Mile Increments**

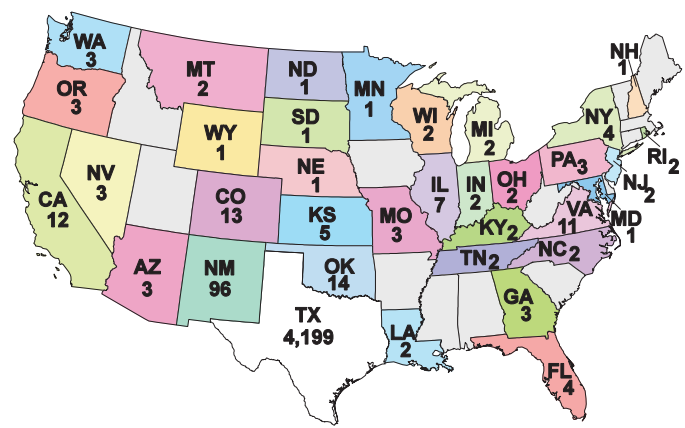

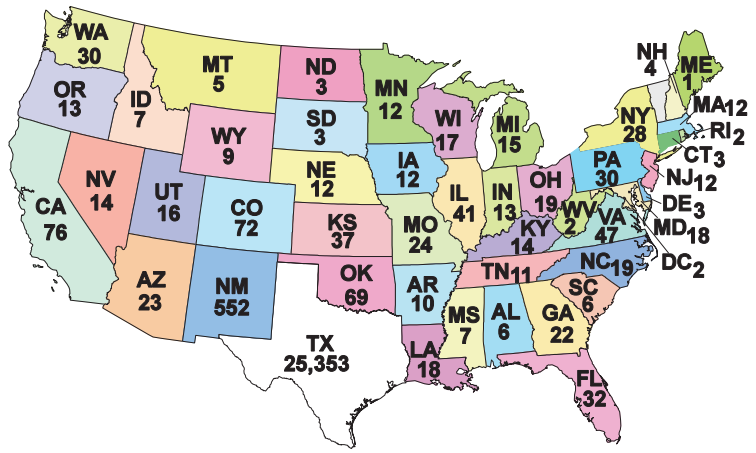

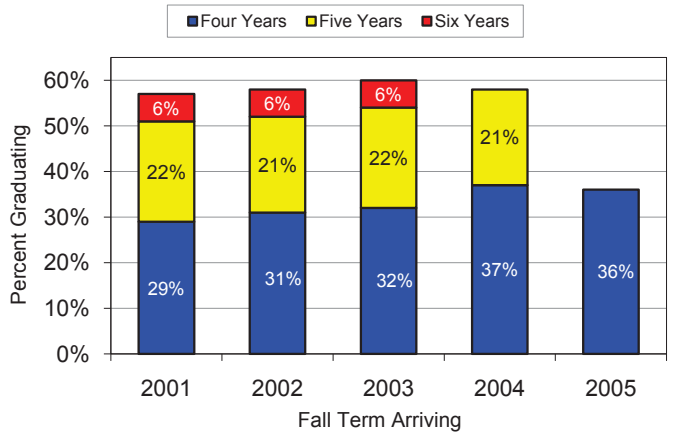

Six-Year Graduation Rate of Full-Time New Freshmen

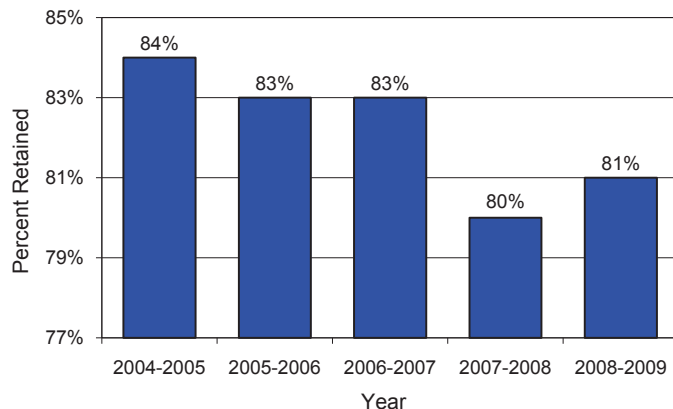

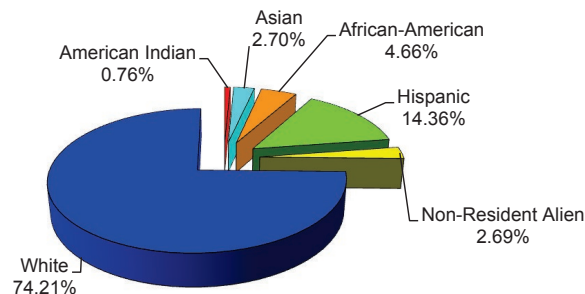
One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen Fall 2004 to Fall 2008*



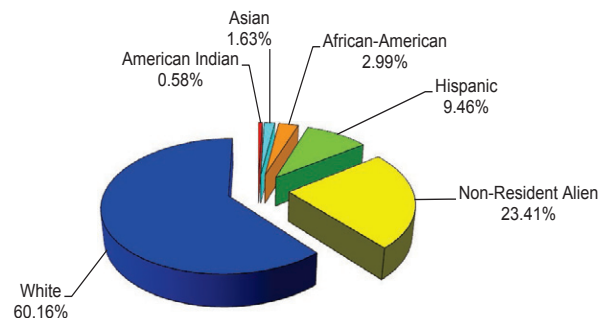

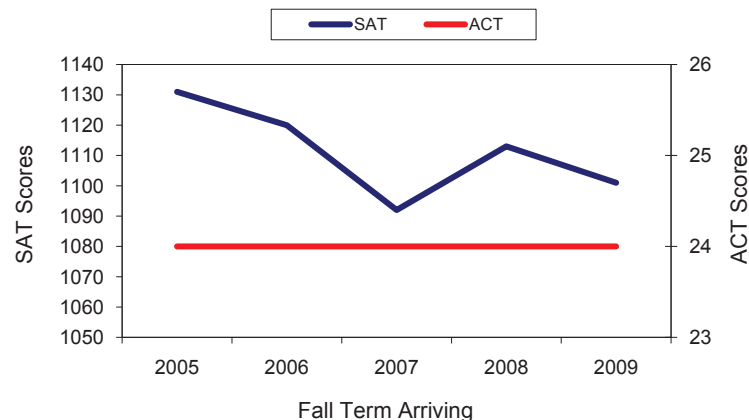
