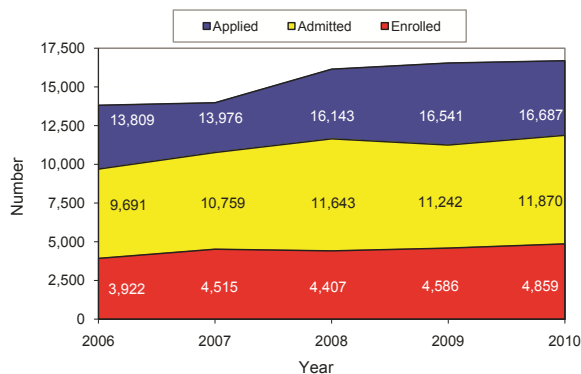
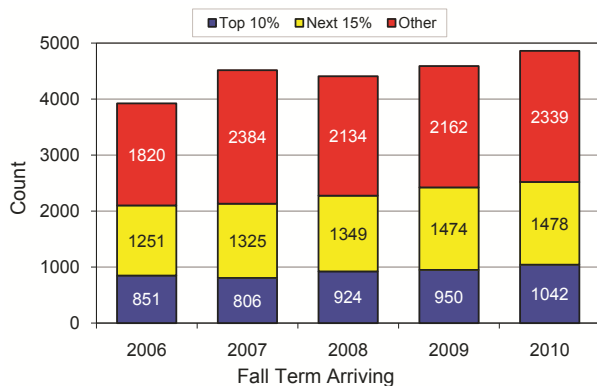

New Freshmen* from High School by High School Rank



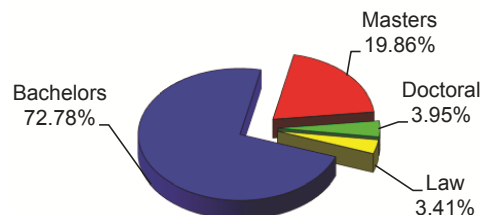

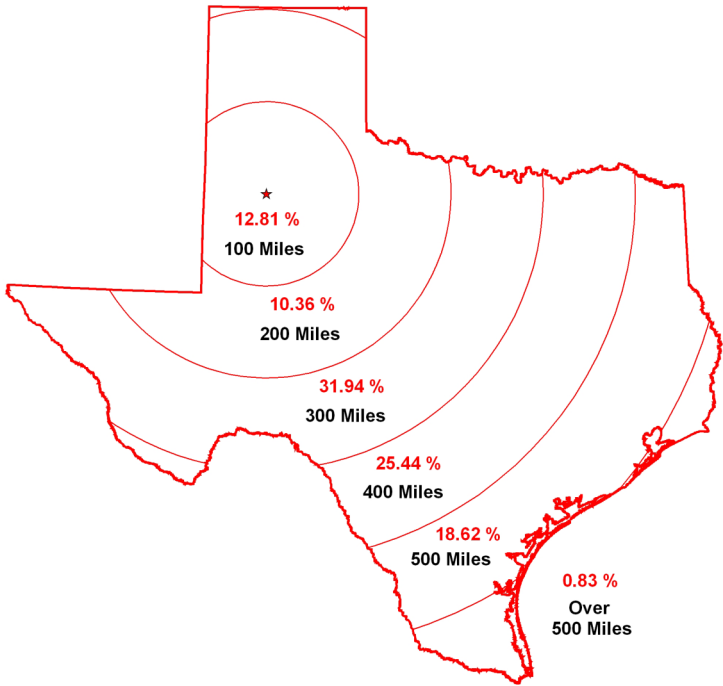

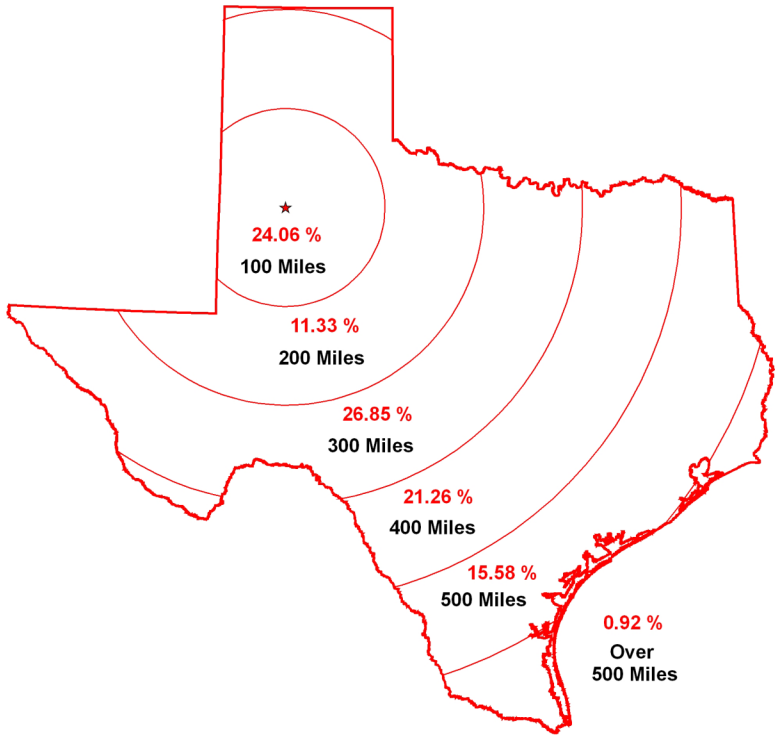
Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas

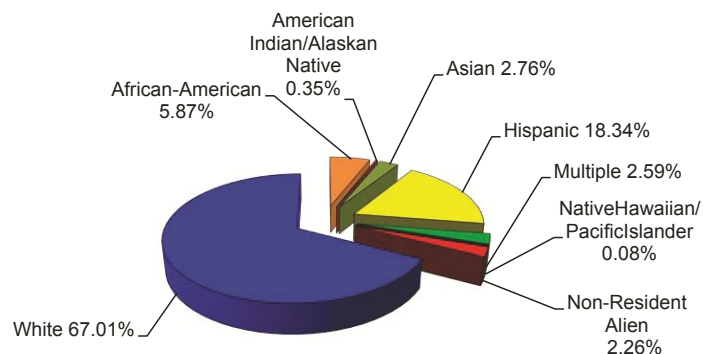

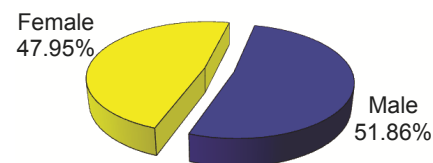

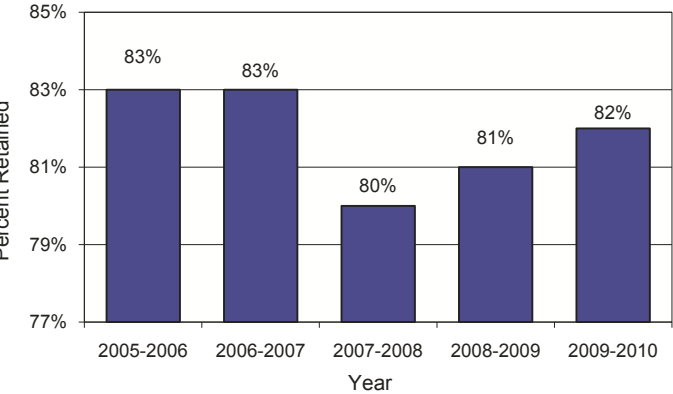

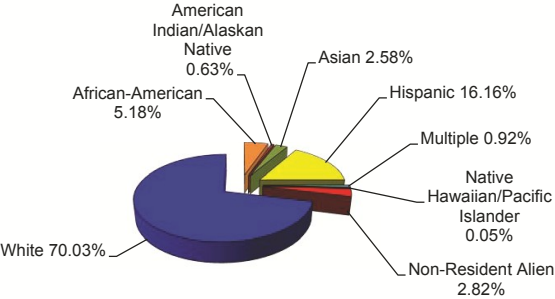
One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen Fall 2005 to Fall 2009*



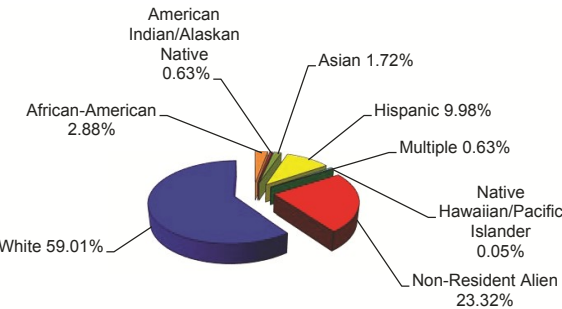

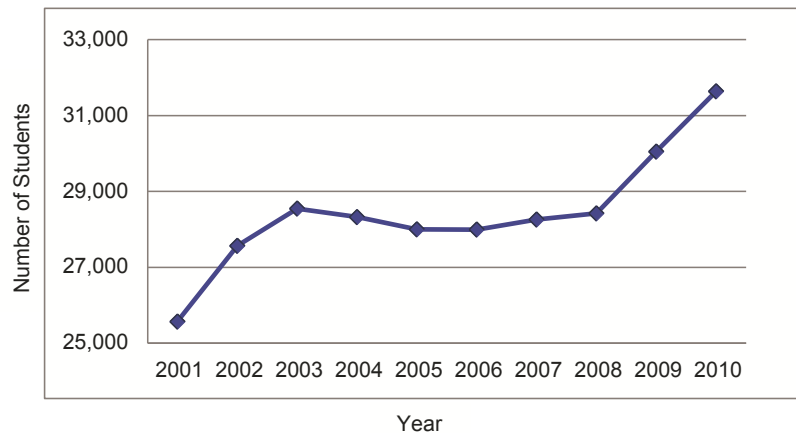

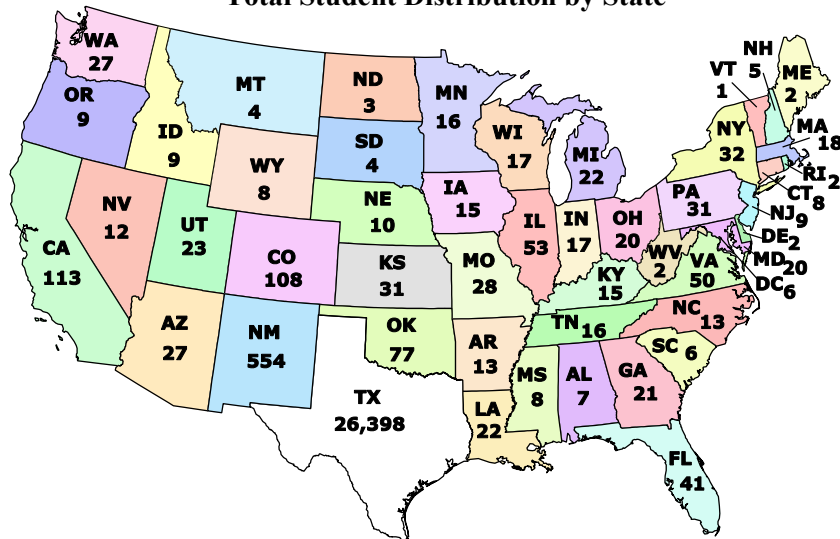

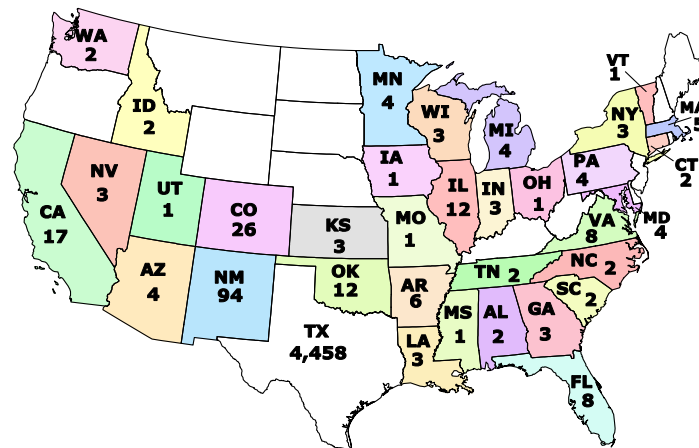

Total Student Distribution by State



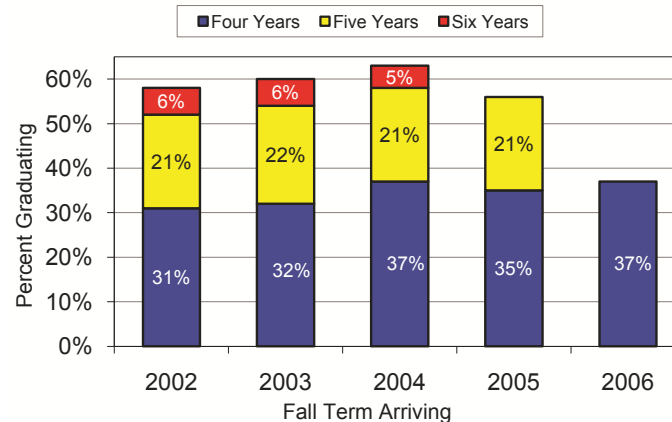

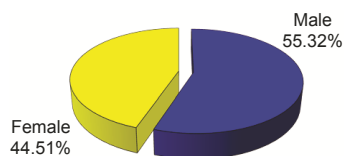

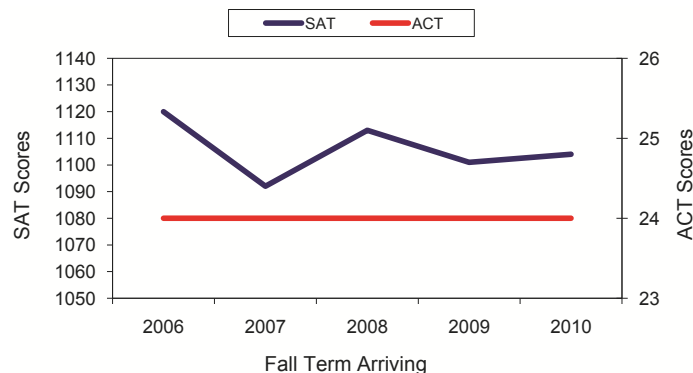
