








Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by 100-Mile Increments




Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by County




Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by 100-Mile Increments



Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by County




Total Fall Enrollment Last 10 Years







Six-Year Graduation Rate




One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen Fall 2006 to Fall 2010*












