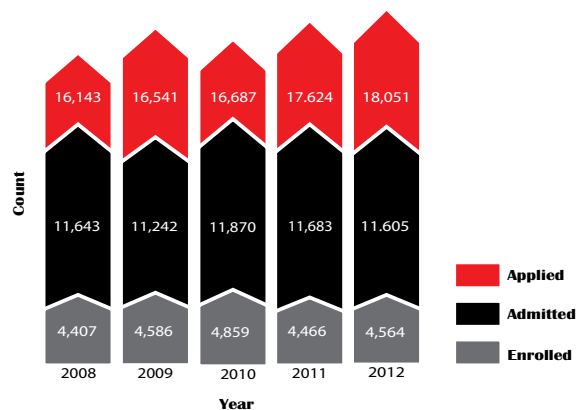

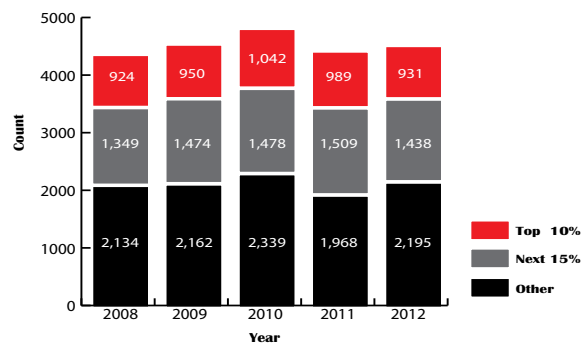

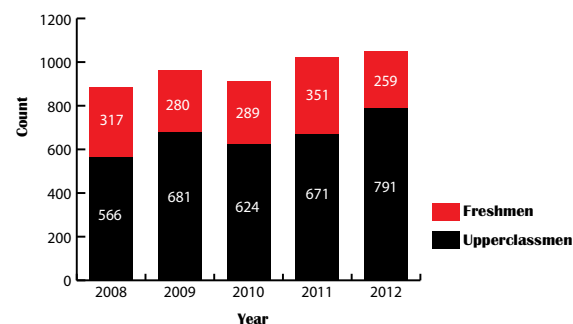

**Financial Aid**

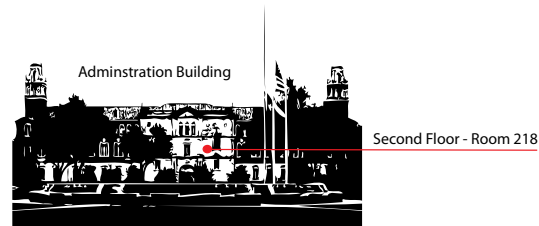
- Over 70% of TTU students receive some type of financial aid including scholarships, grants, work study and loans.

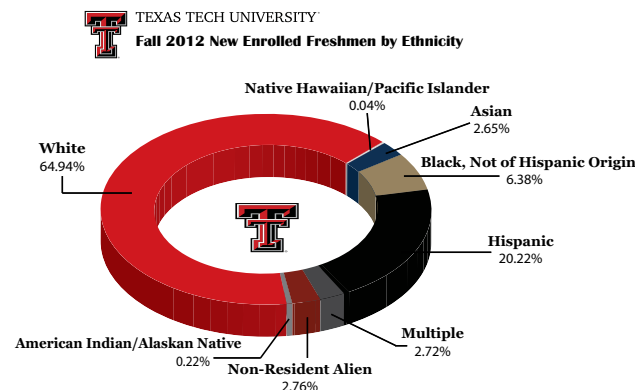

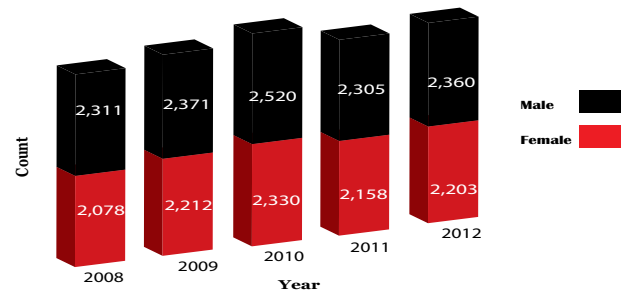

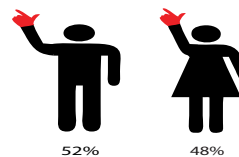


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**New Enrolled Freshmen by Gender**



**Fall 2012 New Enrolled Freshmen by Gender**

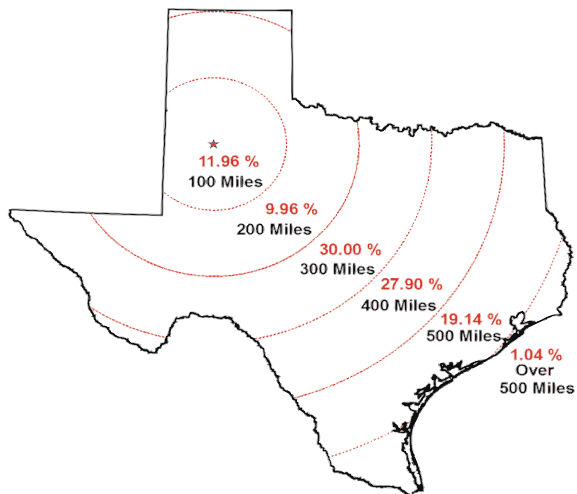




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### Fall 2012 Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by 100 Mile Increments

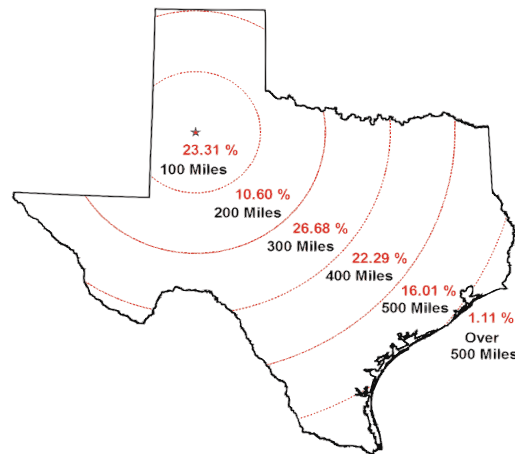

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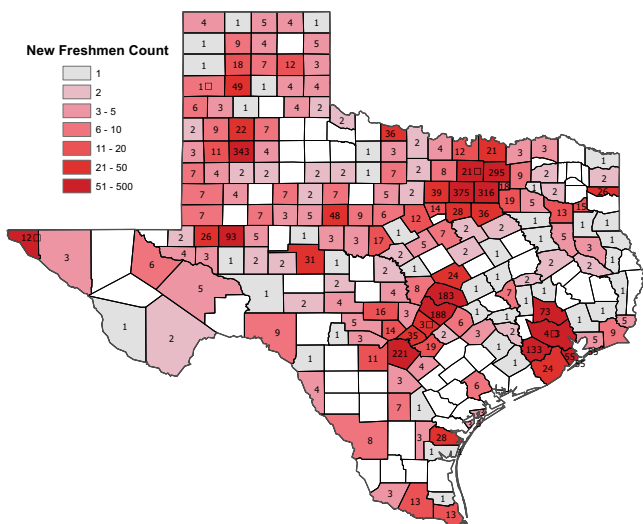

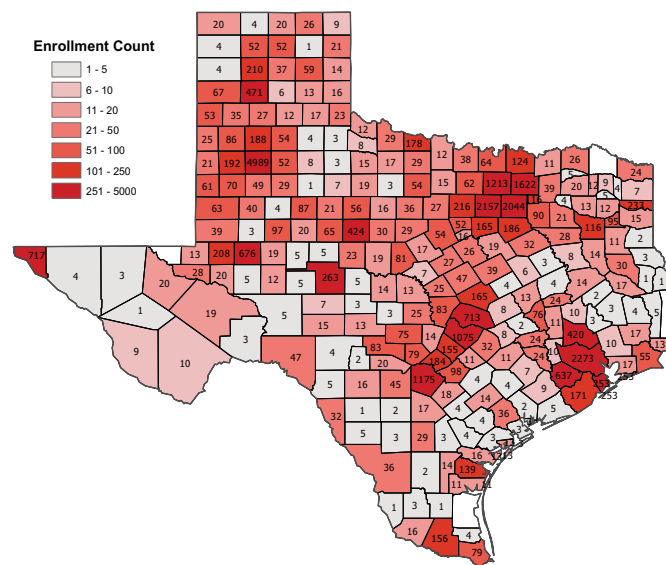
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### Fall 2012 Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by County



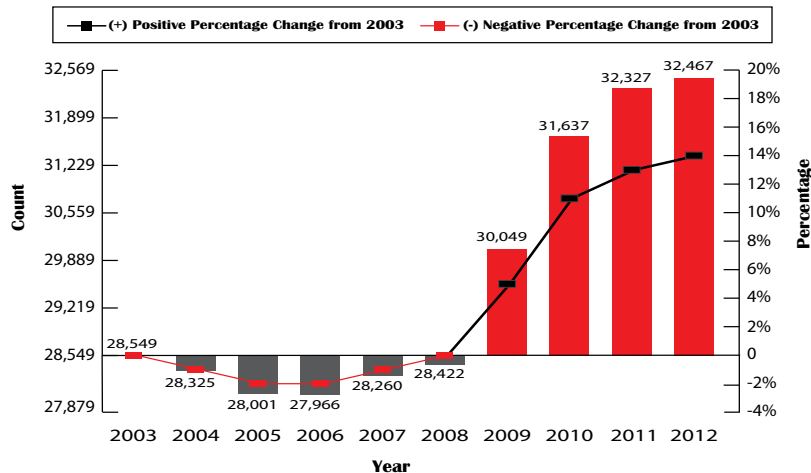
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### Fall 2012 Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by County

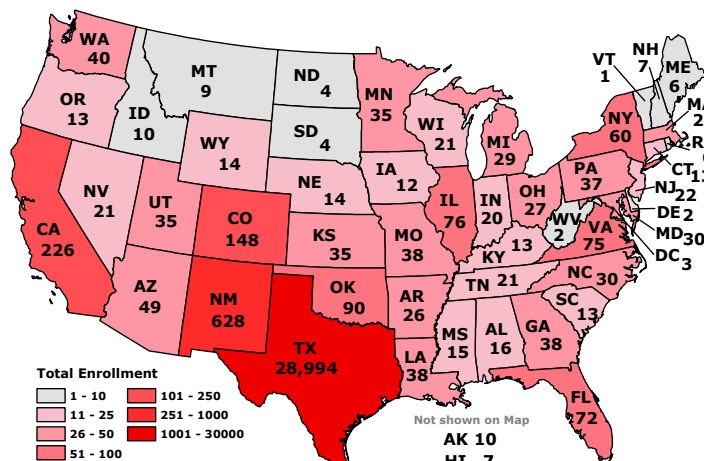

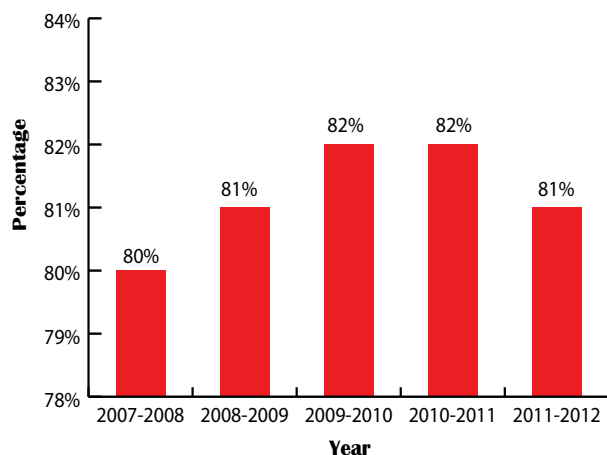

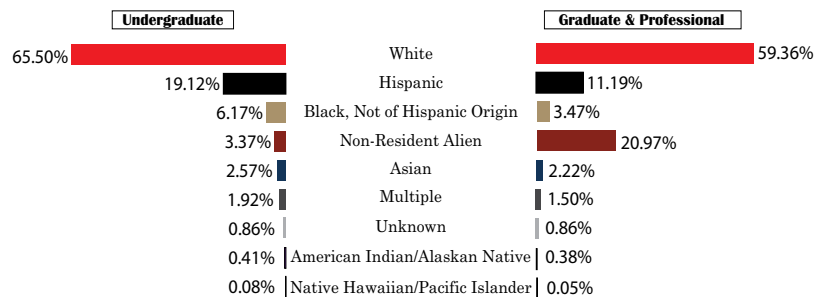
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**One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen

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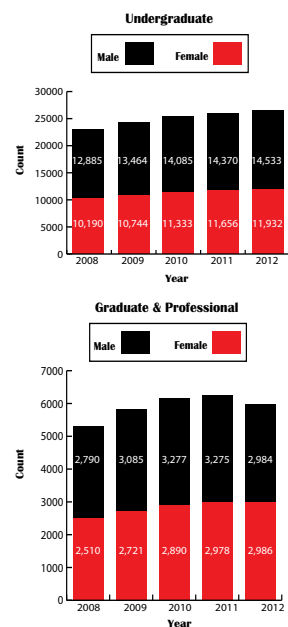

## Fall 2012 Total Enrollment by Gender



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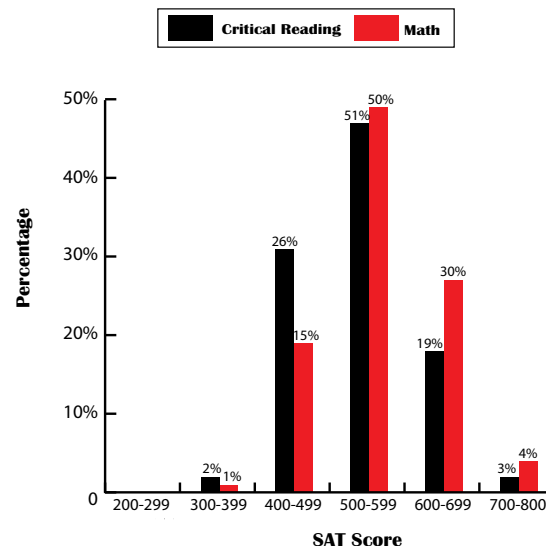

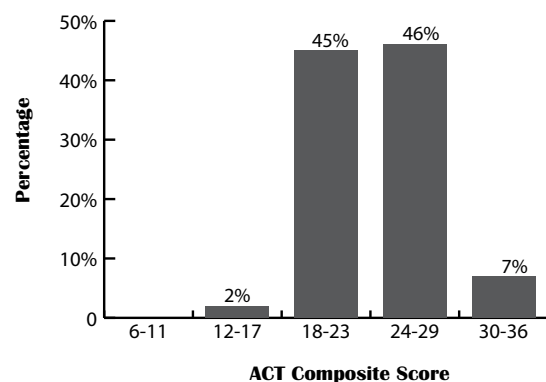

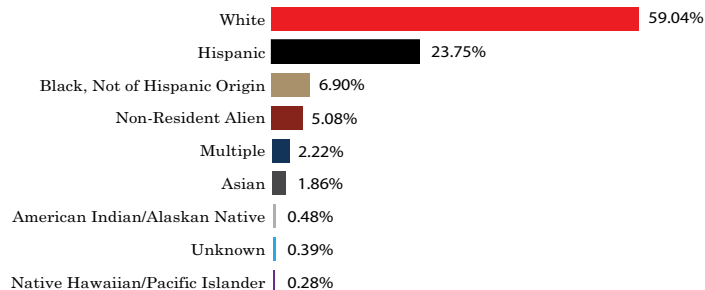
