
### Fall 2017 New Freshmen by Gender



Fall 2017 New Freshmen from High School by High School Rank





Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by County




Graduation Rates for Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen, Fall 2009 - Fall 2013 Cohorts





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




- Over 70% of TTU students receive some type of financial aid including scholarships, grants, work study, and loans.

# Fall 2017 Total Enrollment Over 10 Years



Fall 2017 Distribution of Total Enrollment by State




Fall 2017 I Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by 100 Mile Increments




