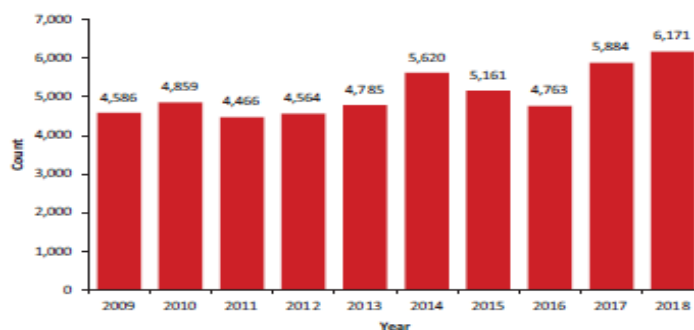

New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled



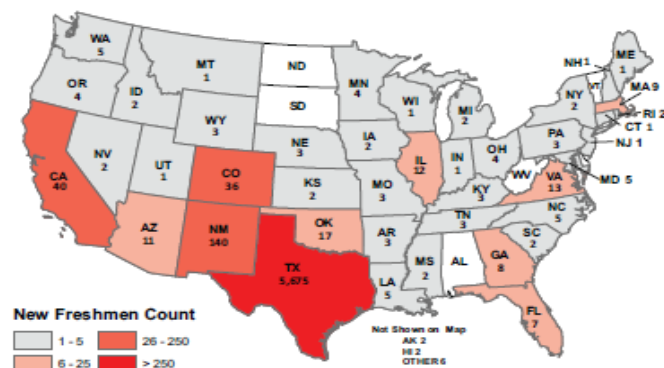

Distribution of New Freshmen by State

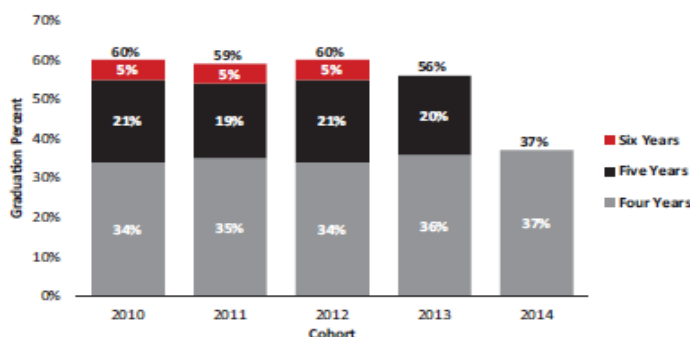

**Graduation Rates for Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen, Fall 2010 - Fall 2014 Cohorts**

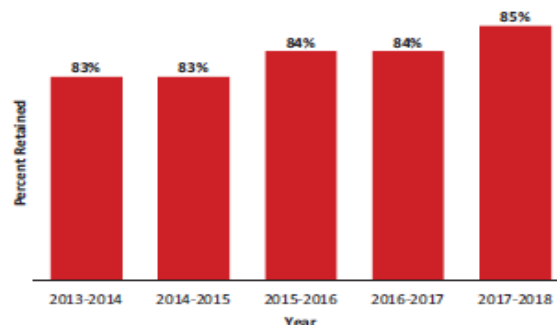

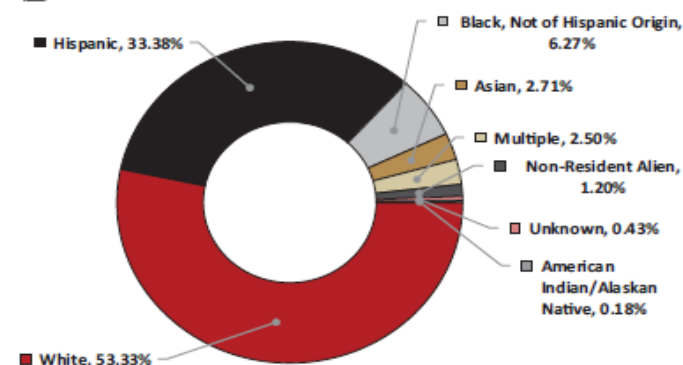

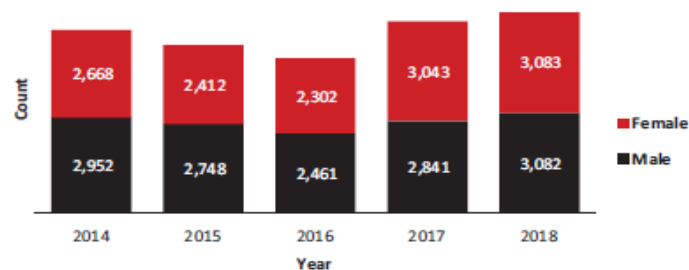

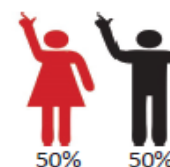
### Fall 2018 New Freshmen by Ethnicity



### Fall 2018 New Freshmen by Gender

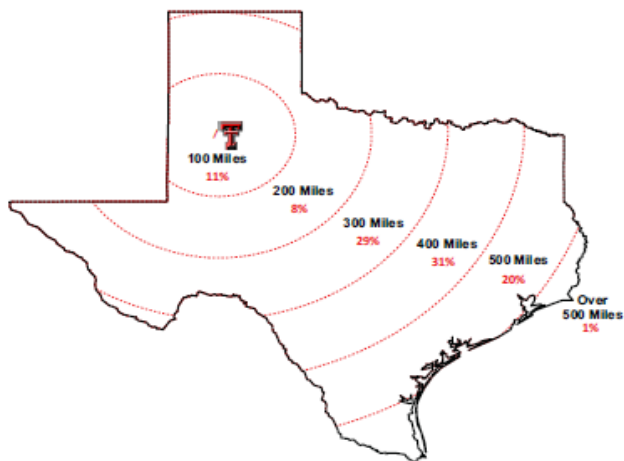

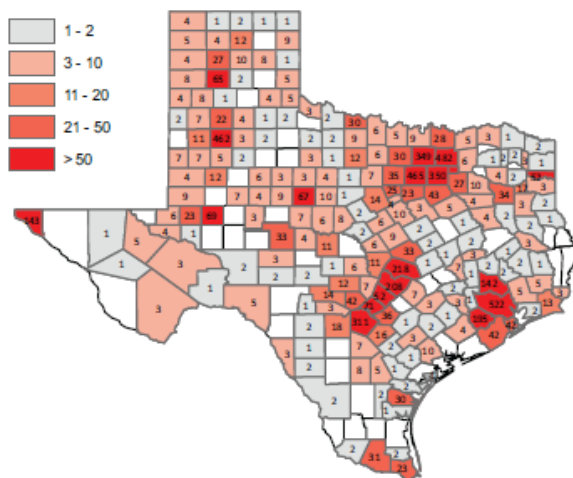

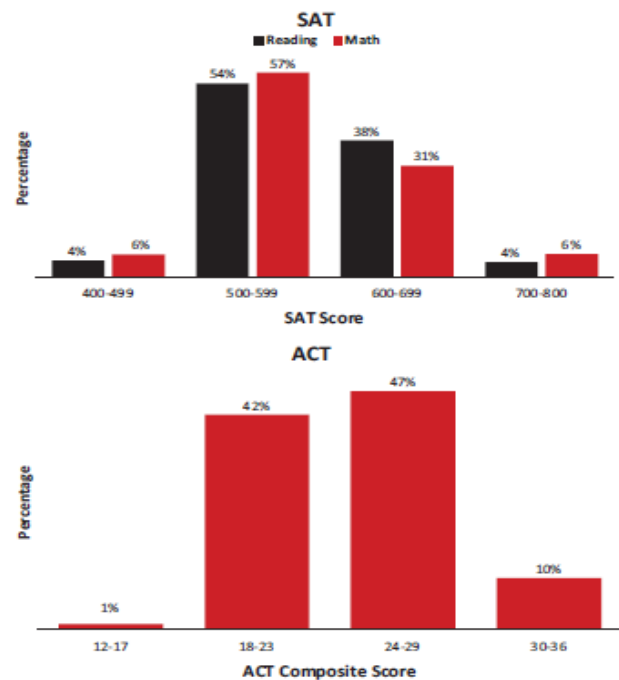
### Fall 2018 Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by County

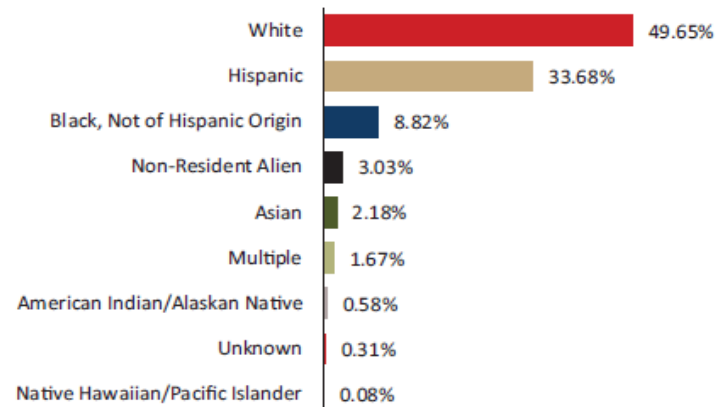

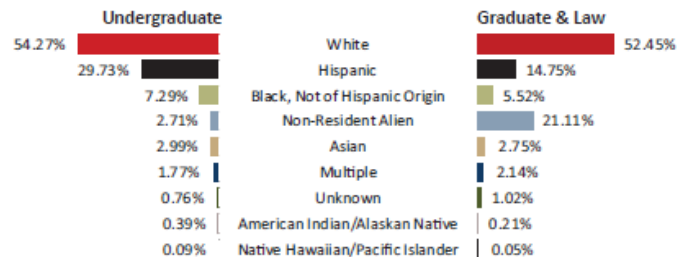

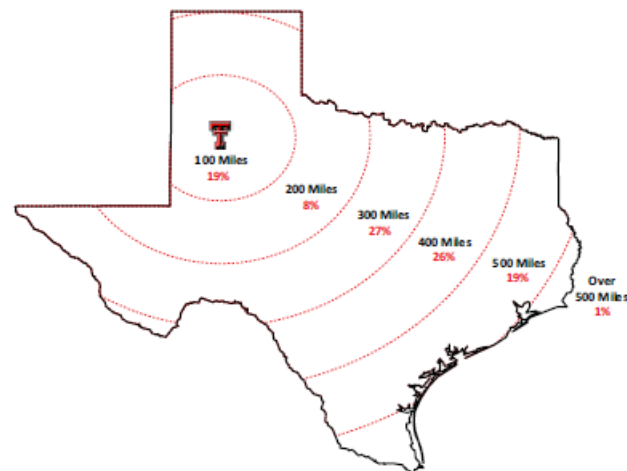

### Fall 2018 Total Enrollment by Gender

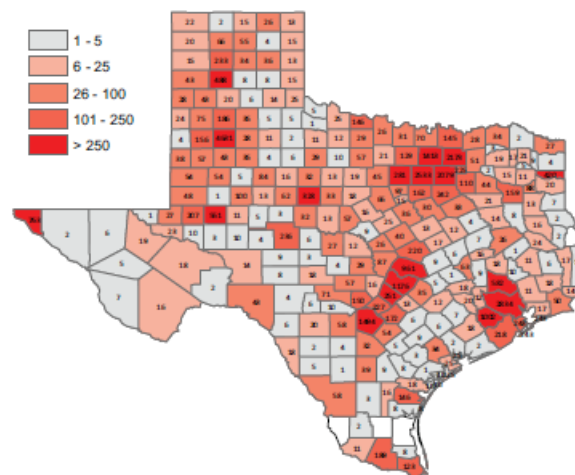

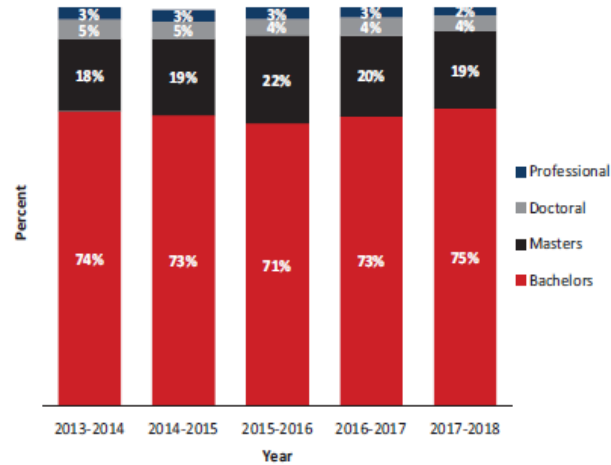
### Fall 2018 Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas by County

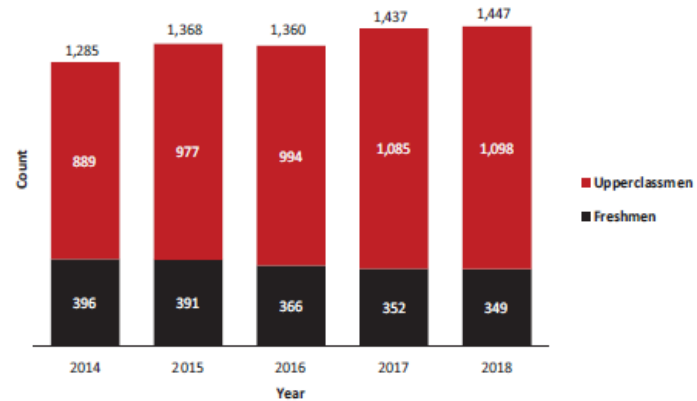

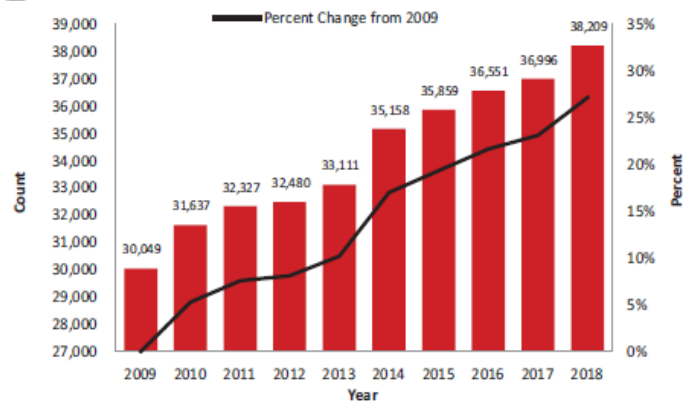


### Fall 2018 Financial Aid

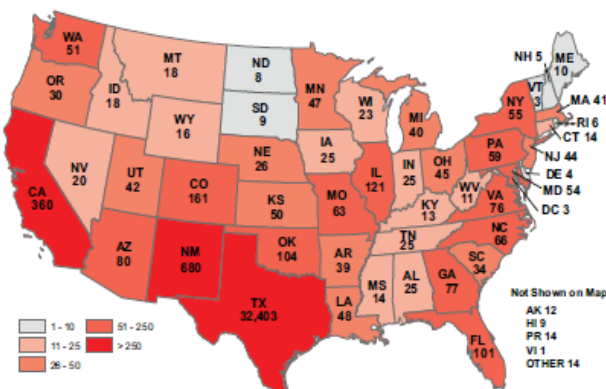
