



Fall 2017 New Freshmen by Gender




Fall 2017 Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by 100 Mile Increments


Fall 2017 Total Enrollment Over 10 Years




Fall 2017 Total Enrollment by Geographic Origin

Fall 2017 Distribution of New Freshmen by State



2017 Six-Year Graduation Rate for Full-Time, Degree-Seeking New Freshmen









Fall 2017 Total Enrollment by Gender








