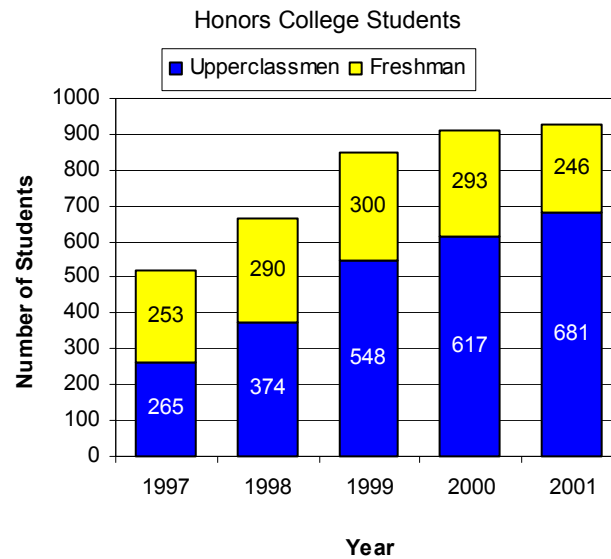

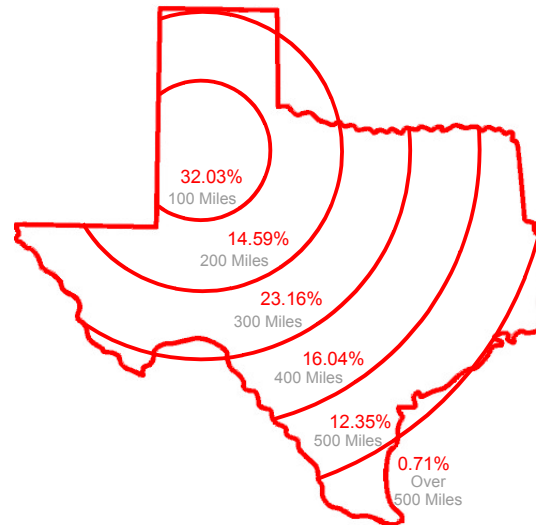

Did you know?

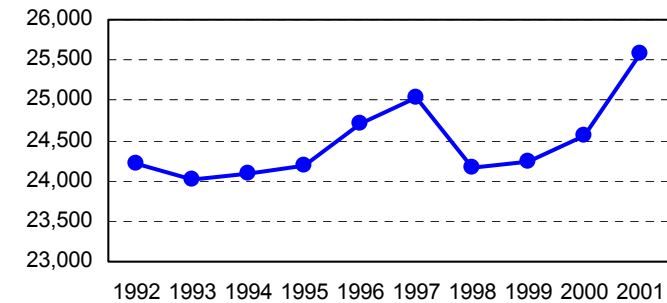
- Since 1998, the number of freshmen applying to Texas Tech has increased 56.89%.
- Since 1998, the size of the freshmen class has increased 24.49%.
- Since 1998, the mean SAT for entering freshmen has increased from 1077 to 1112.
- Since 1998, the size of the transfer class has increased 16.28%.

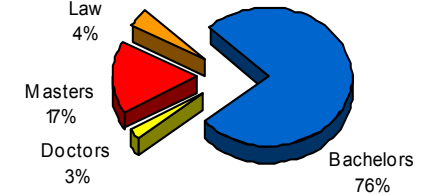

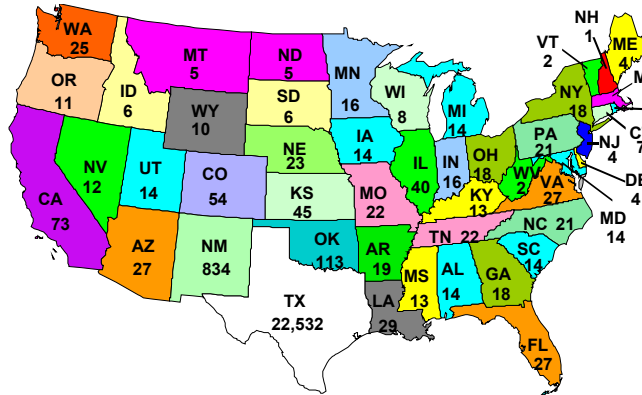

Student Distribution by State



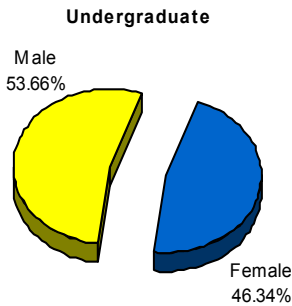

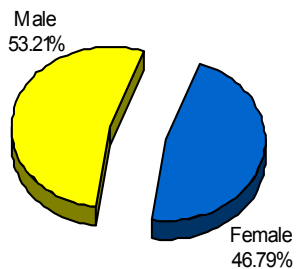

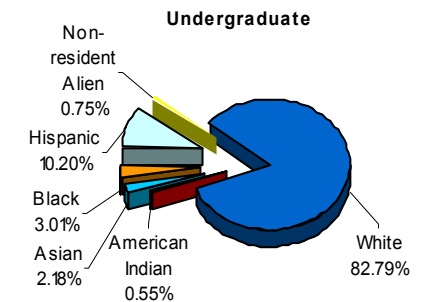

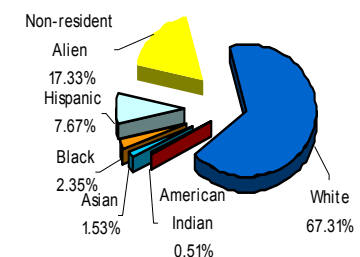

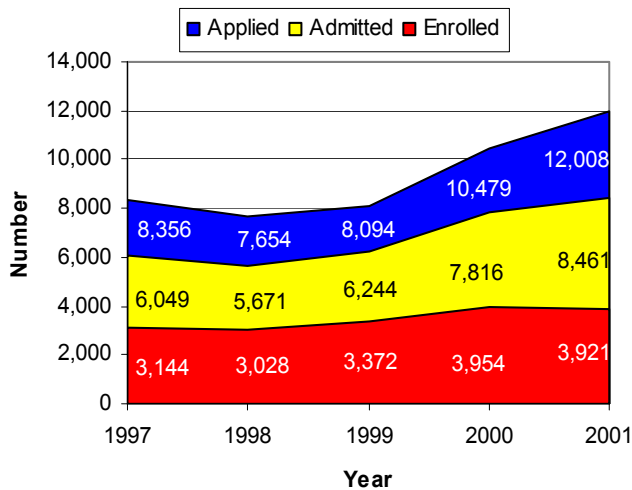

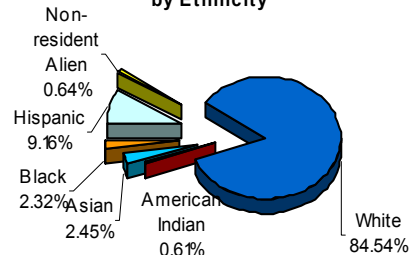

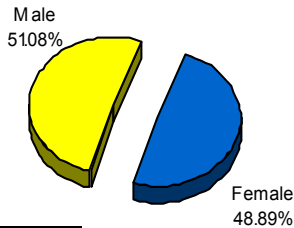

New Enrolled Freshmen by Ethnicity

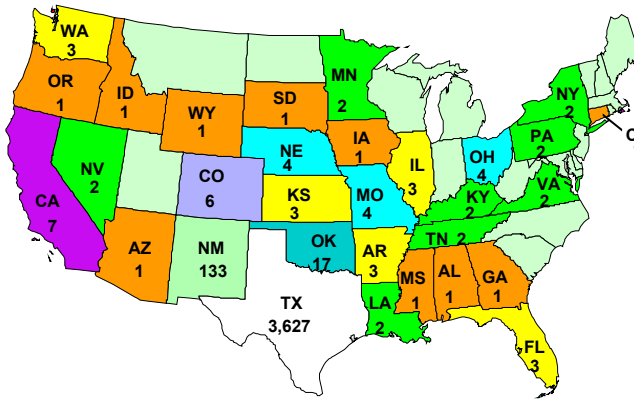


New Enrolled Freshmen by Gender

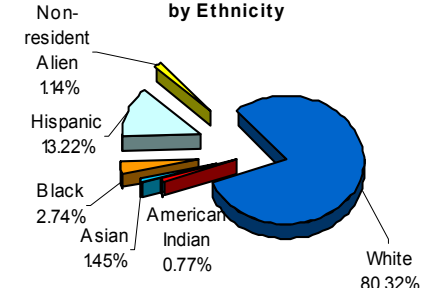
New Freshman Distribution by State



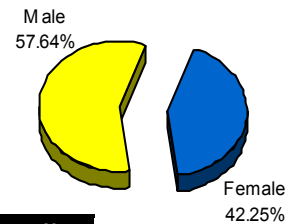

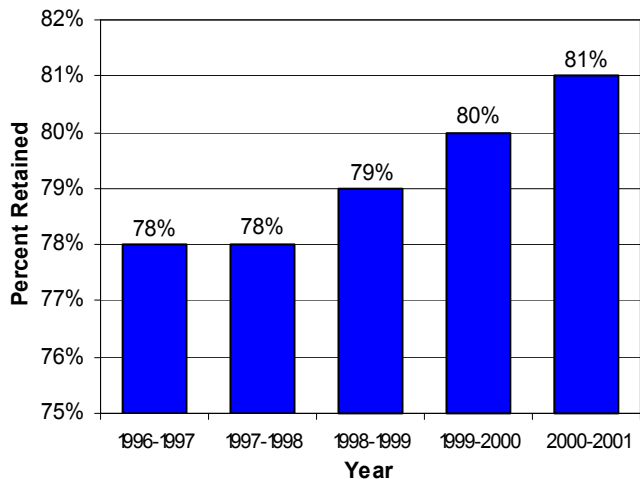

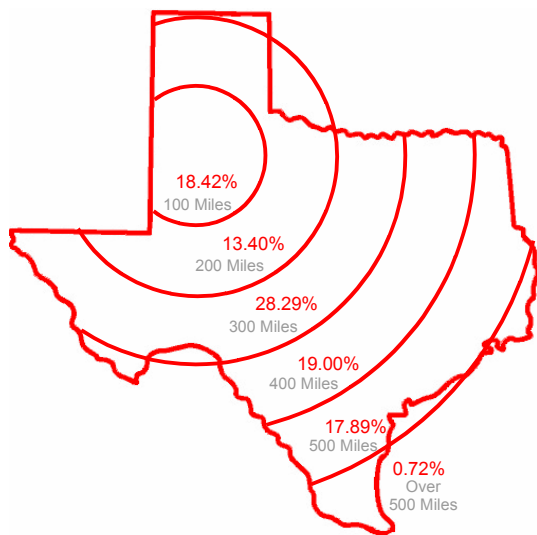
One Year Retention Rate of New Full-Time Freshmen*

Distribution of New Freshmen from Texas by 100-Mile Increments

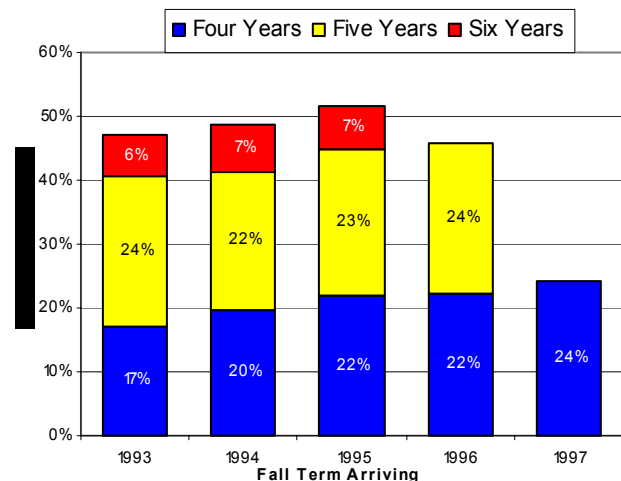
