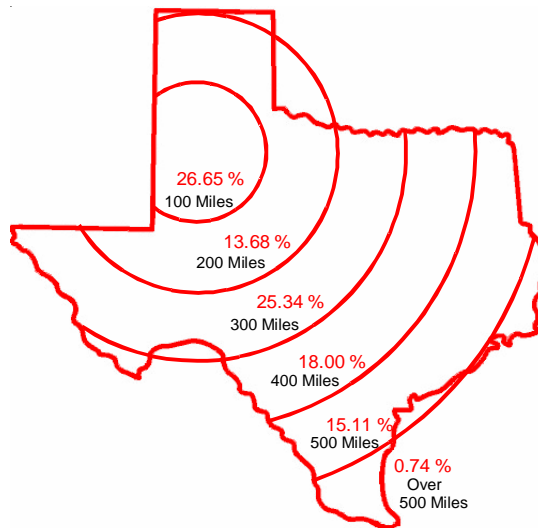

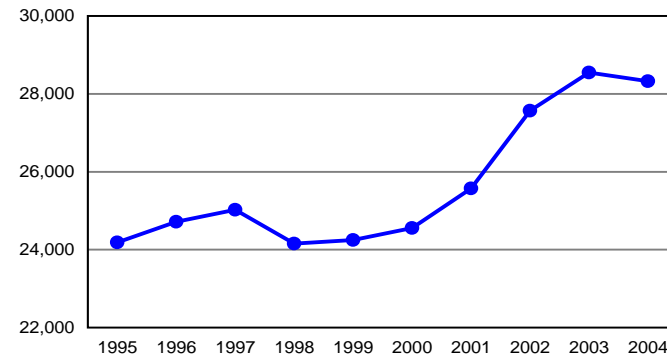

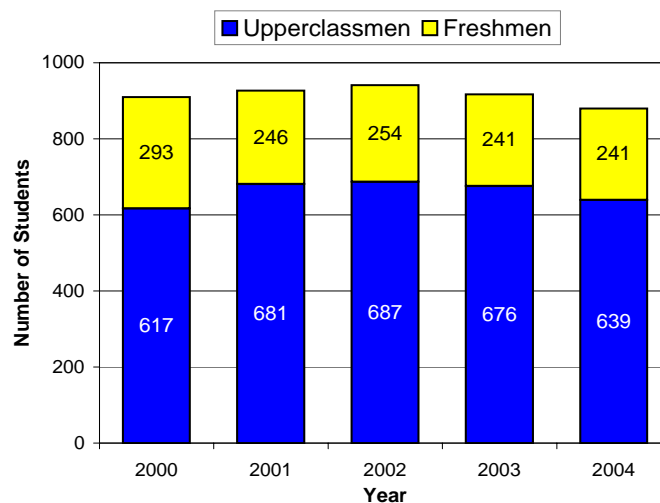
Distribution of Total Enrollment from Texas

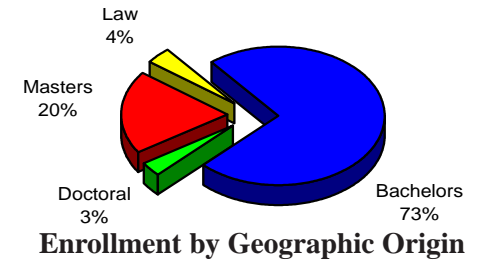

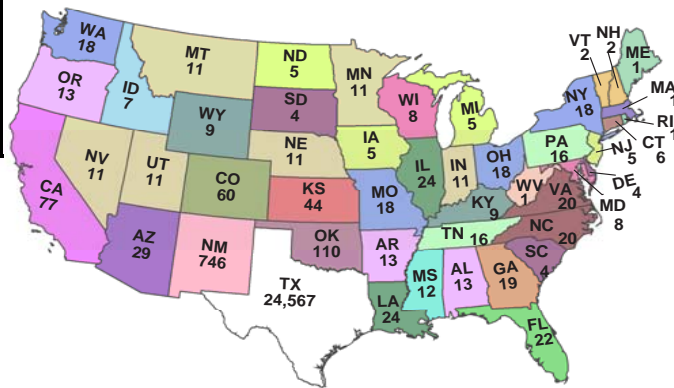

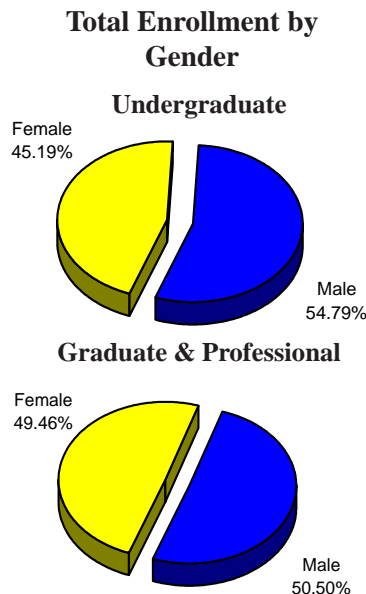
Total Student Distribution by State

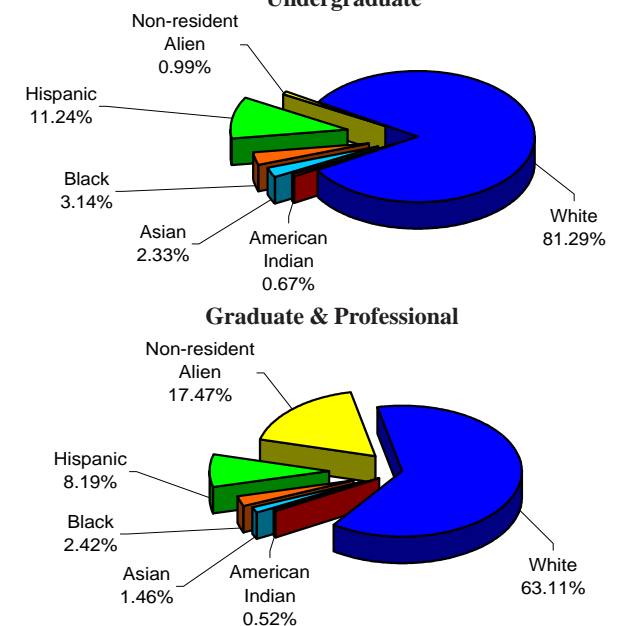

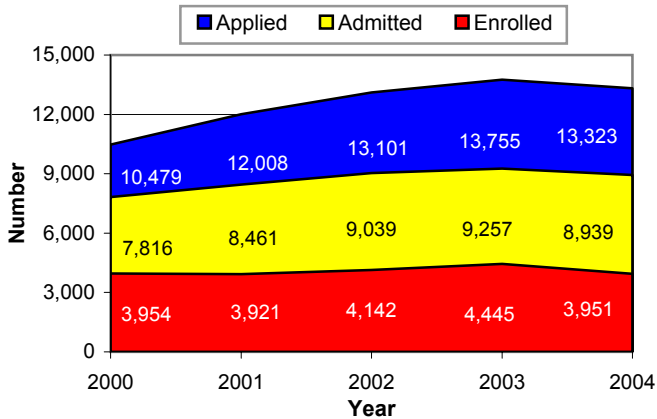

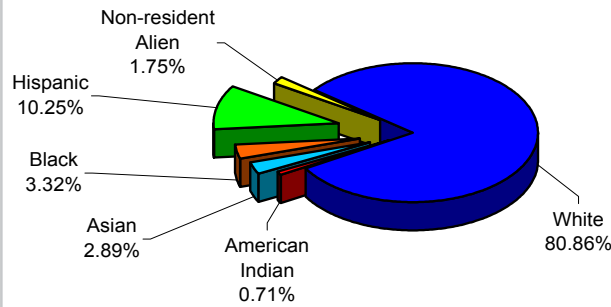

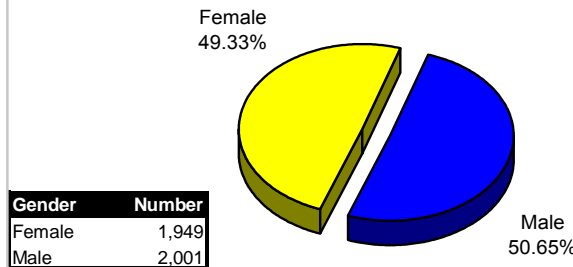

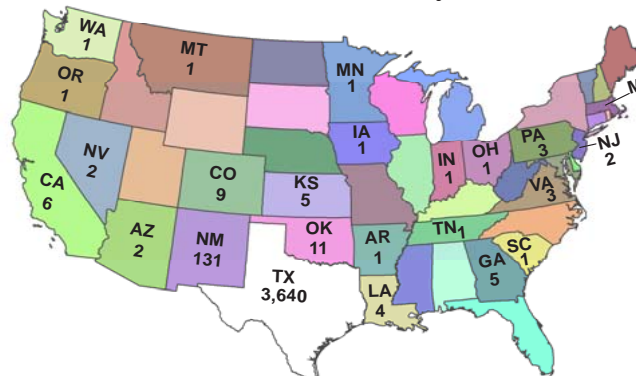
New Enrolled Freshmen by Ethnicity



New Enrolled Freshmen by Gender



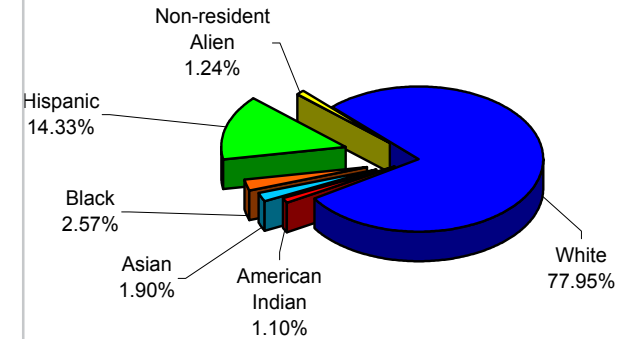
New Freshmen Distribution by State



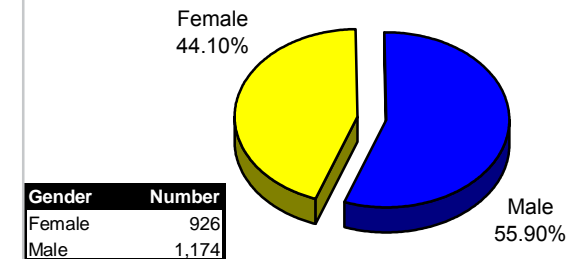

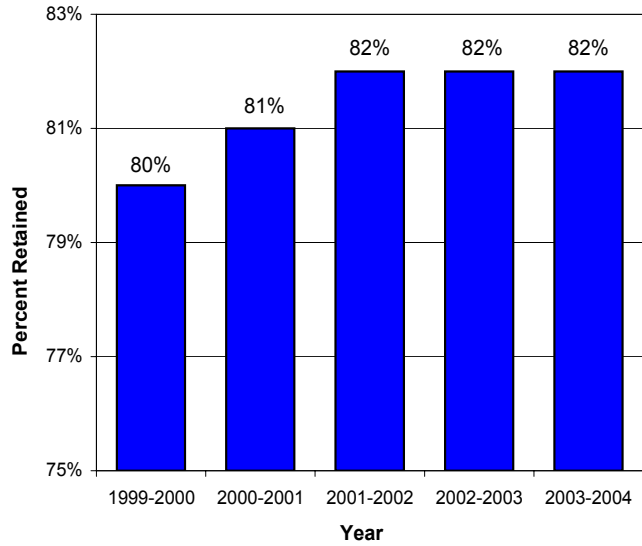

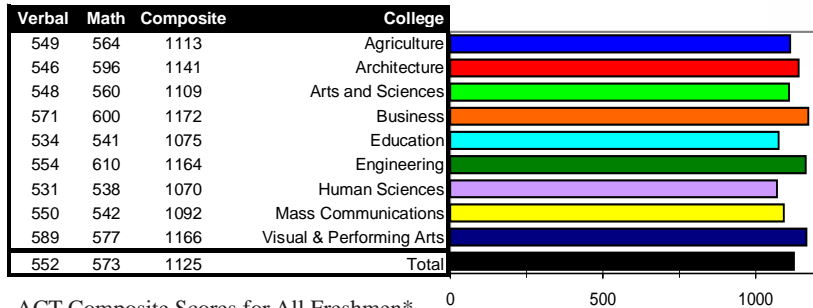
One-Year Retention Rate of New Full-time Freshmen* FY 1999 - 2000 to FY 2003 - 2004



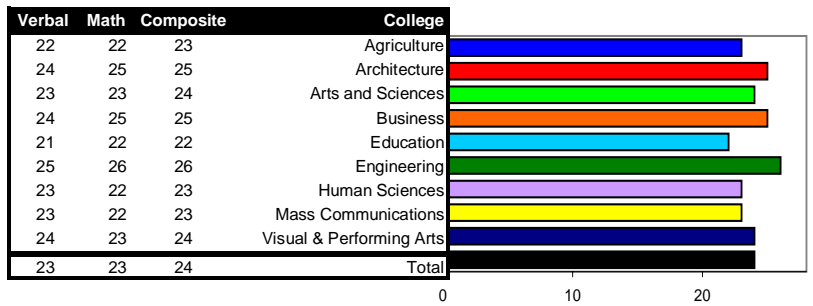
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SAT / ACT Scores for All New Freshmen

SAT Composite Scores for All Freshmen*



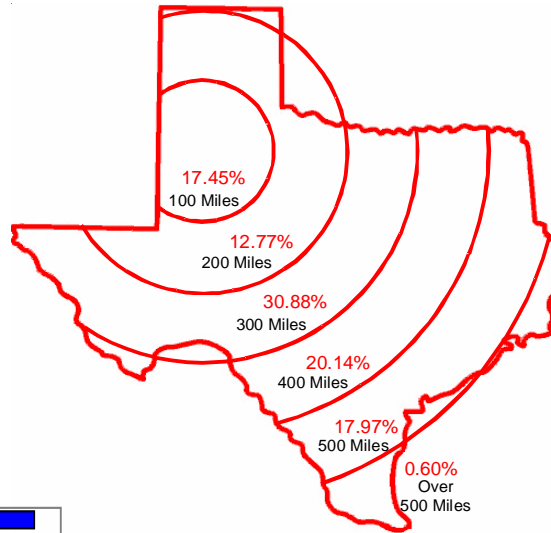
ACT Composite Scores for All Freshmen*



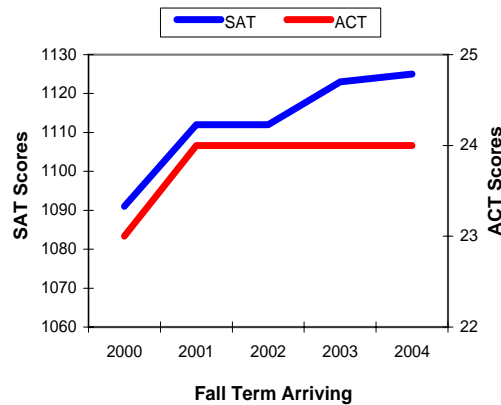

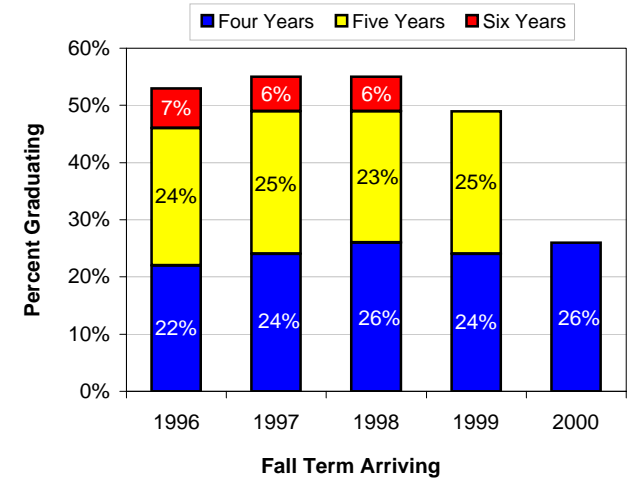
