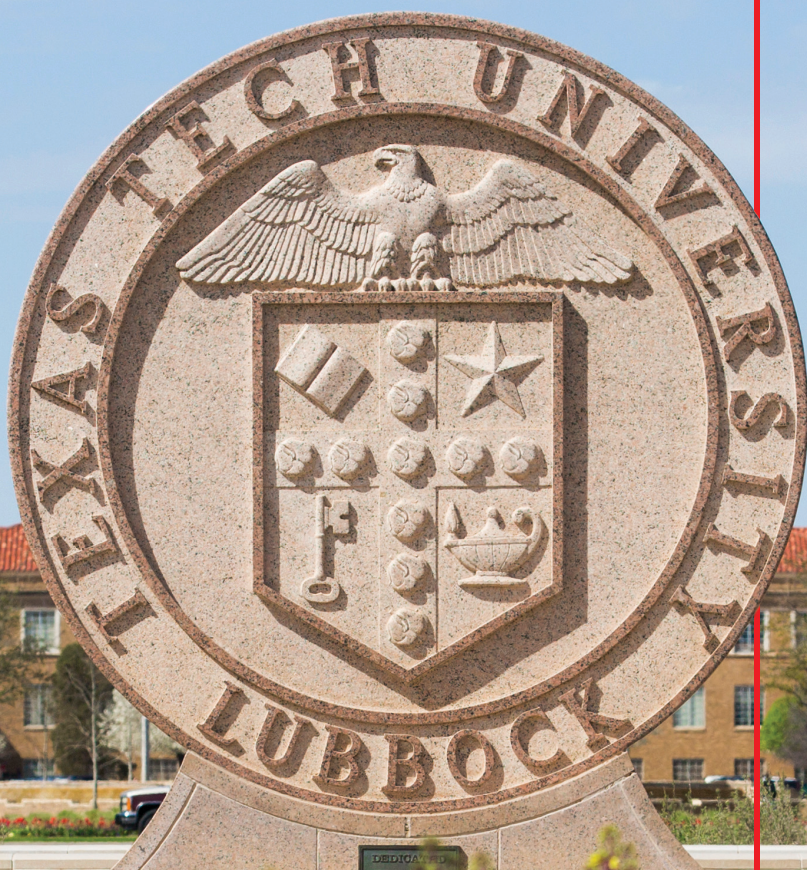

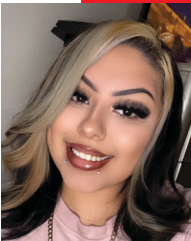

The 2024-2025 graduates come from four states in the U.S. - Florida, Oklahoma, North Carolina and Texas (93) and three foreign countries - Brazil (79), Australia and Mexico (4).

The highest GPA in this year’s graduating class is 4.56 and there are 14 students with a 4.0 GPA or higher. The average GPA is 3.32. End-of-course exam averages are 4363 for English 1, 4393 for English 2, 4246 for Algebra 1, 4328 for Biology and 4426 for U.S. History.
