Required Materials

- Pencil
- Sketchbook
- Charcoal or oil pastels
- Paper towels
- Two-dimensional surface to draw on, like cardboard, construction, or white paper
- Camera or device to take photographs
- Air-hardening clay or other sculpting material
- Objects to make texture in the clay, like a toothpick or plastic knife
- Wax paper or newspaper
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Ruler or straightedge
- Acrylic or washable paint in red, yellow, blue, black, and white
- Watercolor paint
- Three paint brushes: liner, flat, and round
- Thick watercolor paper or cardboard
- Water cup
- Paper towels
- Paper plate, cardboard, or paint palette

Optional Materials

- Protractor
- Compass
- Grid paper
- Kneaded eraser
- Fixative spray, page protector, or frame
- Materials that could be used for sculptures, including recycled objects, flexible materials, objects from nature, broken electronics, repurposed objects
- Glue or another adhesive
- Box to store sculpture
- Apron or large shirt
- Easel
- Tape
- Photo editing program
- Scrap paper or newspaper
- Scissors
