

REGISTERING FOR AN AP EXAM

1. Go to [Get the Most Out of AP](#)

--if you have already created a College Board account in prior years (for SAT or PSAT), then you will need to use that same account information. If you do not remember your log in information, then follow the prompts to reset your password.

--if you have not created a College Board account previously, then click Create an Account. Write down your log in information and keep it in a safe place as you will be using this many times...including for score reports!

2. Join your class section. Click [here](#) for instructions on joining your AP Class section. The class code for your section is listed in the chart below. If you are taking multiple AP courses, you will need to enroll in the class section for each class.
