

SPMT Internship FAQ – SPMT 4376/4378

Is the internship course REQUIRED for all students?

The internship course (SPMT 4376) is a required course on the Sport Management Undergraduate degree plan. Students must be a Sport Management MAJOR (and senior by hours) to enroll in the internship course. NOTE: Sport Management minors & concentrations cannot take this course. SPMT 4378 is an elective course and can be completed after or within the same semester as SPMT 4376.

How do I enroll in the course?

The internship courses are permit-only, meaning students cannot add the course on their schedule without permission from the KSM Advisors and the Faculty Internship Coordinator. To be granted a permit in the course, students must meet the criteria above and submit a completed questionnaire (see internship website) to the Internship Coordinator before the deadlines for each respective semester. Check the website for the semester deadlines.

When is the internship offered?

The internship course is offered in fall, spring, and summer semesters.

When can I start the internship course?

Students must be a senior (by hours & SPMT major) to enroll in the internship course.

How many credit hours is the internship?

Each internship course (SPMT 4376 & 4378) are 3 credit hours.

How many weeks/hours is the internship?

The internship should run the entire duration of the semester but interns are required to complete 200 contact hours for each 3-credit hour course. NOTE: Students who sign up for both SPMT 4376 & 4378 in the same semester are required to complete 400 contact hours at the internship site.

Where can I intern?

The internship must be completed at a sport-related site. Sites must be approved by the Internship Coordinator prior to being granted a permit in the course. Many of our students intern with TTU Athletics, Lubbock Christian University, the Lubbock Matadors, and local school districts. Internships outside of Lubbock or the state of Texas are also acceptable if it aligns with your other coursework schedule.
