*Extended internship, or combination study abroad and 3-month internship must be approved by the department no later than mid-fall semester of the third year.

Directed Electives are subject to approval of the academic advisor and department chairperson and must include at least 5 hours of 3000-4000 level courses.

*Off campus internship, or internship combined with study abroad option. Variable Credit- 3 minimum for spring or summer internship with up to 6 for spring semester + summer internship. Study abroad can be spring or summer, however an internship of at least 6 months is required with prior approval.

**LA Design Studio 6 will involve professional collaboration. Students will review semester collaboration studio options and seek faculty approval for enrollment in a specific course section.
