The Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) requires accredited programs to provide reliable information to the public on accreditation status and performance. This information is intended to help potential students make informed application decisions.

## Accreditation

The Texas Tech University (TTU) offers the following first professional Landscape Architecture LAAB Accredited Degrees. Please note that a first professional degree (BLA or MLA) from an LAAB accredited program is required to obtain a license to practice landscape architecture.
