

Emiliano Buis

Dr. Emiliano Buis is a Professor at the University of Buenos Aires (UBA) Law School, where he holds the Chair of Public International Law. He is also a Senior Researcher at Argentina's National Science and Technology Council, focusing on issues related to international law and security, disarmament, non-proliferation, and arms control.



Dr. Buis is the Director of the UBA Observatory of International Humanitarian Law and oversees its Postgraduate Diploma in Nuclear Law. He has managed interdisciplinary projects at various academic institutions in Argentina and abroad and for NGOs working in non-proliferation and disarmament verification.

Previously, he was a Legal Adviser on strategic trade control, UN Security Council Resolution 1540, and non-proliferation at the Directorate for International Security, Nuclear, and Space Affairs (DIGAN) of the Argentine Ministry of Foreign Affairs. With over twenty years of experience, he has been an expert consultant in these fields for several organizations.

Recently, the Office of Legal Affairs at the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) awarded Dr. Buis the Serge Lazareff Prize for his contributions to NATO's legal services.
