Application Checklist



1. ESTABLISH YOUR ACCOUNTS

- Create a free account at www.LSAC.org
- Create an account with Credential Assembly Services (CAS) through LSAC
- Research law schools and use your resources (prelaw advisor, local law school forums and fairs, and the LSAC Official Guide.)

2. IMPORTANT APPLICATION DATES

- Application Opens: September 1, 2021
- Regular Decision Deadline: March 1, 2022

*Applications received from March 2nd - May 1st will be accepted, however, your chances of gaining admission or a scholarship will be greatly diminished.

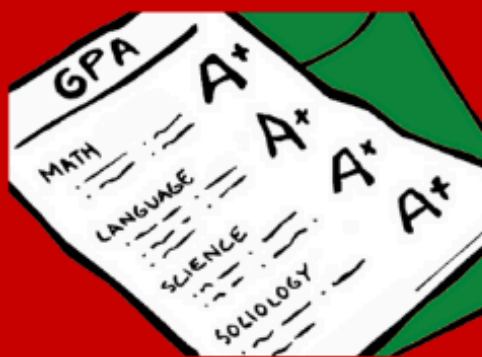


3. APPLICATION FEE

The application fee has been waived for the 2021-2022 admissions cycle!

4. LSAT

All applicants seeking admission to the J.D. program at Texas Tech Law must take the LSAT. LSAT scores are reportable for up to five years. To meet the March 1 deadline, January 2022 LSAT is the last test we will accept.



5. TRANSCRIPTS

A transcript from each college or university you have attended must be sent directly to CAS. When you receive additional grades, you should submit an updated transcript to LSAC.

6. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Texas Tech Law requires two letters of recommendation. We encourage you to request letters from professors and/or employers - individuals in a position to speak about your abilities and professionalism.





7. PERSONAL STATEMENT

Please prepare a two page, double spaced personal statement to assist the Admissions Committee in its decision. While there is not a specific prompt, it is beneficial to at least mention your interest in law. Proofreading is a must.

8. RESUME

A resume is required to complete your application. Please keep the resume to a two pages maximum. This is your opportunity to highlight any extracurricular activities, community service, leadership, work experience, etc.
