## **1. Student Input**

## **2. Administrative Positions and Areas of Responsibility**

Below is also a list of some of the Law School's administrative positions along with major areas of responsibility for more particularized input.

- a) Associate Dean for Student Life and Director of Wellness: student life, student organizations, wellness
- b) Program Manager for Special Events: student events
- c) Assistant Director, Student Financial Aid and Scholarships: financial aid
- d) Assistant Dean of Academic Services & Registrar: registration, course schedules, graduation requirements
- e) Associate Dean for Academic Affairs: course offerings and instructors
- f) Director of Academic Success Programs: academic success and bar success
- g) Associate Dean for Administration and Finance: law building and maintenance
- h) Director of Academic Technologies: IT
- i) Associate Dean and Director of the Law Library: law library
- j) Assistant Dean of Alumni Relations and Communications: communications
- k) Assistant Dean for Career and Professional Development: employment
- l) Assistant Dean of Admissions: admission
- m) Director of Dual-Degree Programs & Concentrations: dual-degree programs and concentrations
