

Hello Percussionists:

The 2022 ZIT DRUMLINE audition music for the Texas Tech University Marching Band-Goin' Band from Raiderland consists of warm-ups/exercises/cadences/show music {"ZIT-GB18 Warmup," "16th Note Grid," "Cheesy Poofs," "ZIT 60," & "76 Trombones" for Snares and Tenors/"ZIT-GB18 Warmup," "16th Note Accent Grid," "ZIT 60," & "76 Trombones" for Basses/"ZIT-GB18 Warmup," "16th Note Accent Grid," "ZIT 60," & "76 Trombones" for Cymbals. Additionally, Cymbal auditionees may be asked to mark time and perform upbeat, hi-hat crashes at various tempi.

Welcome back John Frederick, who will be working with the Texas Tech Drumline also known as ZIT this year.

A. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE AUDITION MUSIC:

Snares*

1. "ZIT-GB18 Warmup" - tempo is quarter note = 120, **mark time** to the quarter note pulse while playing.
2. "16th Note Grid" - tempo is quarter note = 100-120, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End.
3. "Cheesy Poofs" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 140, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End.
4. "ZIT 60" - tempo is quarter note = 145-160, **NO marking time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End.
5. "76 Trombones" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 128, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to Letter B.

***Please make sure to practice audition music with a metronome, as we may ask you to play along with the metronome at your audition.**

Tenors*

1. "ZIT-GB18 Warmup" - tempo is quarter note = 120, **mark time** to the quarter note pulse while playing.
2. "16th Note Grid" - tempo is quarter note = 100-120, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End on **Drum 2**.
3. "Cheesy Poofs" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 140, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End on **Drum 2**.
4. "ZIT 60" - tempo is quarter note = 145-160, **NO marking time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End.
5. "76 Trombones" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 128, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to Letter B.

***Please make sure to practice audition music with a metronome, as we may ask you to play along with the metronome at your audition.**

Basses*

1. "ZIT-GB18 Warmup" - tempo is quarter note = 120, **mark time** to the quarter note pulse while **playing the Snare Drum Part**.
2. "ZIT-GB18 Warmup" - tempo is quarter note = 120, **mark time** to the quarter note pulse while **playing the Bass Drum Part of your Choice**.
3. "16th Note Accent Grid" - tempo is quarter note = 100-120, **mark time**, **1st time play through AS WRITTEN & 2nd time play through with ACCENTS ONLY**.

4. "ZIT 60" - tempo is quarter note = 145-160, **NO marking time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End the Bass Drum Part of your Choice.

5. "76 Trombones" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 128, **mark time**, and PLAY from Beginning to Letter B the Bass Drum Part of your Choice.

***Please make sure to practice audition music with a metronome, as we may ask you to play along with the metronome at your audition.**

Cymbals*

1. "ZIT-GB18 Warmup" - tempo is quarter note = 120, **mark time** to the quarter note pulse while playing.

2. "16th Note Accent Grid" - tempo is quarter note = 100-120, **mark time**, PLAY from Beginning to end **WITH ACCENTS ONLY**.

3. "ZIT 60" - tempo is quarter note = 145-160, **NO marking time**, and PLAY from Beginning to End the Cymbal Part of your Choice.

4. "76 Trombones" - tempo is dotted quarter note = 128, **mark time**, and PLAY FROM Beginning to Letter B the Cymbal Part of your Choice.

5. Cymbals only - **mark time** and play hi-hat upbeats at various tempi as directed by adjudicators.

***Please make sure to practice audition music with a metronome, as we may ask you to play along with the metronome at your audition.**

B. If you are auditioning for SNARE DRUM, please remember we are a "MATCHED GRIP" drumline.

If you are auditioning for BASS DRUM, please pick a drum when there are split parts and audition on that particular drum for us. FYI!, This may not be the drum that you end up playing if you make the drumline. Additionally during MONDAY'S meeting (August 15, 2022) and time allotted for playing on TTU drumline equipment, we will ask people to play together as a bass line on different drums in order to already assess your strengths and weaknesses in playing together.

If you are auditioning for CYMBALS, there are split parts in "ZIT-GB18 Warmup," ZIT 60" & "76 Trombones." Therefore, pick the part that you will be auditioning on for us.

C. We, STRONGLY, STRONGLY, STRONGLY, STRONGLY encourage you to PREPARE COMPLETELY the audition music for more than one instrument; this INCLUDES MEMORIZATION FOR MORE THAN ONE INSTRUMENT.

Again, MEMORIZATION AND MARKING TIME ARE EXTREMELY IMPORTANT PARTS OF THE AUDITION/SELECTION PROCESS. THE ONLY PART OF THE AUDITION PROCESS WITHOUT MARKING TIME IS DURING YOUR PERFORMANCE OF ZIT 60.

D. Auditions for the drumline will occur on TUESDAY, August 16, 2022 from approximately 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. in the TTU School of Music Percussion Studio (018). Then, if you make the drumline, there will be rehearsals until 4:30 pm with an early dinner break from 4:30 to 6:00 pm. Next, you'll have uniform fitting from 6:00 to 7:30 pm and a final evening rehearsal from 7:30 to 10:00 pm.

- E. On MONDAY, August 15, 2022, there is a **REQUIRED** general meeting from 9:00 to 9:30 a.m. in the School of Music Hemmle Recital Hall followed by a morning marching session for ALL percussionists from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. in the band parking lot. Then, from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., time is allotted to continue settling in your dorms/apartments/homes as well as grab lunch. From 12:30 to 1:00 p.m., there is a percussion specific meeting in the School of Music Band Hall (011) with Mr. Frederick, Dr. Rogers, and Mr. Mixtacki. You will then practice on the TTU drumline equipment from approximately 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. in hopefully the TTU School of Music Band Hall (011) and/or other designated areas TBA. Then, an early dinner provided by the Goin' Band Association in the band parking lot from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m.
- F. Additionally, if you are planning to audition for the TTU Concert Bands, Orchestra, and/or Percussion Ensemble 1, more information and the audition music should be available starting the first part of June 2022 on the TTU School of Music Website (www.ttu.edu/music). The audition music is the same for all percussionists (Non-Major or Major), consisting of one snare drum etude and one mallet etude along with sight-reading at the audition. When you go to the TTU School of Music website (www.ttu.edu/music), check under the "Ensembles" heading and click on "Performing Ensemble Auditions."

If you are interested in our TTU Steel Drum Band program, please contact Dr. Lisa Rogers regarding auditions for TTU Steel Drum Band 1 and/or playing in TTU Steel Drum Band 2. More information will be made available regarding the program at the beginning of August 2022.


