The Big 12 Tenor Trombone Solo Competition

The Big 12 Tenor Trombone Soloists Competition will be held at the 21st Annual Big 12 Area Trombone Conference at Texas Tech University, January 12 – 14, 2024. The competition is open to all Bass Trombonists 26 years of age or younger **as of January 14, 2024**.

The winner will receive a total award of **\$1,000.00 in cash and prizes**.

Up to three finalists will be invited to perform in an Honors Solo Recital, held and adjudicated at the conference.

Preliminary audition CD's will be accepted through **November 11, 2023**. The Preliminary and Finals repertoire for Tenor Trombone entries appear below.

Preliminary Round Information:

Each candidate is asked to submit an unedited CD recording of the following piece:

Jongen – Aria and Polonaise (play the original notes only; no “cued” notes)

The chosen work for the final round will be the Bozza - Ballade.

Finalists selected will be expected to provide their own accompanists or use one of the Big 12 Staff Accompanists for a \$60.00 fee.

Make sure the recording is unedited and recorded with piano accompaniment. Be sure to clearly identify yourself on the CD jacket or email correspondence, but not on the recording file itself.
