Entrance Requirements:

1. Apply to the Texas Tech University Graduate School here: https://ttugradschool.force.com/admissions/ApplicationLogin

Required items and submissions include:

- Transcripts: A 4-year undergraduate degree in a music area providing sufficient background to undertake graduate studies in Music Education. Unofficial copies of transcripts are required for application evaluation purposes.
- TOEFL scores: Scores for the Test of English as a Foreign Language must be included with your application if you are an international student. An iBT (Internet-based test) TOEFL score of 79 or above is required for international applicants. - Supporting materials: Certification to teach public schools is desirable. A 20-minute video recording of the candidate's teaching and a personal interview with the music education faculty are required.
- If admitted, you will be required to submit official transcripts, diplomas/degree certificates, and test scores. Please do not send official transcripts until you have received a notice of acceptance from Texas Tech Graduate School.

According to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, students may not hold two similar degrees from the same institution. Therefore, students who hold a Master of Music Education degree of any kind from Texas Tech will not be admitted for a second Master of Music Education. The same restriction holds for the Master of Music, the Doctor of Music, the Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education, and the Doctor of Philosophy in Fine Arts.
