Music History and Literature and Music Theory Preliminary Examinations

Taken at the time of initial enrollment. Depending on results, MUHL 5300, MUTH 5300 and/or MUTH 5301 may be required as leveling courses. Those courses may not be applied toward the Music History or Music theory requirements for any graduate degree in music.

Final Comprehensive Examination

Taken in the final term or enrollment. The examination will demonstrate the student's ability to synthesize and apply knowledge from music history, music theory and major area.
