## **Tenor and Bass Trombone – Instructions and Information**

- 1. Preliminary Instructions
  - a. The audition material consists of the following three elements:
    - i. **Etude Excerpts** everyone plays these
    - ii. Additional Orchestral Excerpts for those auditioning for SWE/Orchestra
    - iii. Sight Reading everyone does this as well
  - b. It is recommended that you listen to recordings of the Orchestral Excerpts to gain accurate ideas of tempo range and style. Visit <u>http://imslp.org/</u> to access scores of the orchestral works for reference. Tempo references for the "Etude Excerpts" are contained in this document.
  - c. *The Brahms Symphony No. 1 Tenor Excerpt is in Alto Clef.* An Alto Trombone Guide is included in this Tenor Trombone PDF bundle.
- 2. Etude Excerpts: From "Semester G" of the Trombone Audition Excerpt PDF's
  - a. Tenor Trombone
    - i. Excerpt 1: Berlioz "Hungarian March" from the "Damnation of Faust" 6 measures before '4' through 2 measures after '5'
    - **ii.** Excerpt 2: Mozart "Requiem" Tuba Mirum Movement Second Trombone Solo beginning through measure 18.
  - b. Bass Trombone
    - Excerpt 1 Berlioz "Hungarian March" from the "Damnation of Faust" – 6 measures before '4' through 2 measures after '5'
    - ii. Excerpt 2 is an Etude by Marco Bordogni. Quarter Note = 96.
- 3. Additional Orchestral Excerpts: for those of you auditioning for SWE/Orchestra.
  - a. Tenor Trombone
    - i. Brahms-Symphony No. 1

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




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Berlioz Damnation of Faust - Hungarian March
