ACADEMIC PLAN

The MS in Ranch Management at TTU requires 36 credit hours: 6 credit hours of internship and 30 credit hours (two semesters) of classes on the beautiful Texas Tech campus in Lubbock, Texas.

REQUIRED INTERNSHIP

Upon finishing the academic coursework, the second year will be dedicated to gaining hands-on experience by working at two distinct ranches as a trainee in ranch management.

Students are required to commit to at least six months of work on each ranch. Compensation consists of a monthly payment of \$1,000, housing, and worker's compensation insurance provided by the ranch.

Students will interact regularly with the ranch owner/manager to discuss ranch decisions and provide input.

At each ranch, students are required to formulate a comprehensive ranch management strategy aimed at enhancing the overall profitability of the ranch. Dr. Rusk will be available for consultations regarding your proposals and to provide guidance. The completed ranch management plan will then be presented to the ranch owner/manager.
