# Institutional Effectiveness Weekly Report July 7, 2017

The Office of Planning and Assessment reports its weekly activities and contributions toward Texas Tech University's institutional effectiveness efforts and departmental objectives.

### **OUTCOME 1: Texas Tech will be found in compliance with all external accrediting agencies and State of Texas mandates**

- → Substantive Change
  - OPA staff met with Dr. Justin Louder and Dr. Clay Taylor from TTU Worldwide eLearning to discuss the approval and notification processes for programs that exceed the 50% rule for distance education. OPA's primary concern was to ensure that documentation was consistent, valid, and reliable.
- → Faculty Credentialing Activity
  - OPA staff met with several staff members, Michele Moskos, Michelle Greenlee, and Jason Rinaldo from the Rawls College of Business. Discussion centered around the possibility of populating Rawls personnel webpages, "Our People," using data from DigitalMeasures. In the past Rawls faculty were required to complete a form that was cumbersome. Then a staff member had to update each individual webpage. Since DM captures virtually all information Rawls' publishes on their webpages, it seems like an intuitive use of the software. OPA expressed confidence that a solution is possible. Next week, Michele Moskos will discuss the proposed change with administrators at Rawls and OPA will talk to IT about how Web Services can make this happen.
  - The Provost's Office has provided information about 73 new faculty hires for Fall 2017. OPA will begin reaching out to these new faculty members to introduce them to DM as soon as they have TTU email addresses. We hope our efforts will present DM as a positive, valuable tool.
  - As TTU prepares to renew our agreement with DM, OPA staff worked with HR staff member, Stephanie Gonzales, to determine the employment status of personnel with DM accounts. The information displayed below was sent to DM and will be very valuable and hopefully cost-saving in this process.
