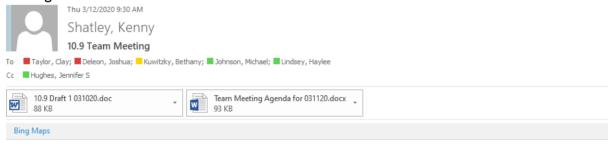

Meeting with Campus 10.9 Leaders

Kenny Shatley and Jennifer Hughes convened a critical meeting on Wednesday, March 11 with campus-wide 10.9 leaders. Standard 10.9 addresses the importance of regularly reviewing cooperative academic agreements. OPA is taking a "reverse" approach with this standard; OPA has already collected evidence, and so we are now writing to the evidence.

<u>Degree Program PAR Faculty Peer Review Data Update</u>

The degree program faculty peer review concluded on February 29, 2020. Libby Spradlin is currently cleaning the data received through the Qualtrics survey to ensure accuracy of data entered before moving into coding the responses for analysis. OPA will create summary reports to provide to Department Chairs at the annual Chairs meetings and will also draft a PAR Summary Report. OPA hopes to have this analysis completed by the end of the spring semester.



Texas Tech University faculty and staff will be well-prepared to meet OPA's faculty credentialing, assessment, and strategic plan expectations.

TxAHEA Update

The TxAHEA Executive Committee met on Friday, March 13. Currently, we are considering marketing options in light of COVID-19. We have received 4 conference proposals thus far. This week, Kahlie Callison met with Wells Fargo Bank regarding the association's banking procedures. Kahlie also met with a t-shirt vendor in preparation for the conference's 2020 t-shirt design.

Meeting with ORS Staff

Earlier this week, OPA met with ORS staff to discuss progress on the integration of DM and Cayuse. This project continues to move forward, and we will provide a more detailed technical update soon.

OPA Collaboration with Dean Belnap

OPA staff had the pleasure of meeting with Dean Belnap on Friday, March 13. Discussion focused on how OPA can support TTU-CR's institutional effectiveness and faculty credentialing needs. Currently, we are preparing a customized annual report for TTUCR faculty, and we are considering ways that TTUCR could report their assessment efforts.

Presentation to Chair's Council

Jennifer Hughes made a short presentation to Chair's Council on Tuesday, March 10. Hughes asked Department Chairs to review their designated degree program coordinators to ensure they are academically qualified to serve in this role. Hughes

spoke briefly about how this evidence supports Texas Tech's compliance with Standard 6.2.c (Degree Program Coordinators). Hughes will email all Department Chairs next Monday, March 16 and Tuesday, March 17. The email will be customized to each department chair.
