Criterion: 70% of students demonstrate critical thinking skills when analyzing sport management issues and best practices. In SPMT 4353, students are assessed based on a research essay where they critically evaluated a sport phenomenon using a social and cultural theory. Students are required to use course concepts and readings and peer-reviewed journal articles to support their argument.

Students will demonstrate critical thinking when analyzing current and proposed sport management practices. (Active)

Criterion: 70% of students will score 70% or above.

In SPMT 4356 students' critical thinking abilities were assessed using a group project that required the students to analyze survey data and propose marketing solutions based on the findings. This meant formulating a report that addressed the following three areas: (1) ability of data analysis; (2) ability to interpret the findings; and (3) ability to develop creative action recommendations.

For this project, students were to develop an oral presentation regarding a sport legal case of their choice. Students had to present their findings to their fellow classmates & the Instructor using their understanding of the case facts, court findings, future implications for sport, and application of legal concepts that we discussed throughout the semester. Also, among the numerous assignments for SPMT 4359, student learning was assessed using a case study focusing on contract law issues in sport. For this case study, students were to research previous or current cases involving contract law and analyze the findings of a specific sport case. Students had to provide a written assignment based on these findings.
